In discussion it was noted that:

- There is substantial local interest in the retention of this building as expressed by I& AP's in writing and before the committee.
- Some of the arguments made by the objectors hinged around town planning and previous non-compliance issues under other laws which are not within the mandate of the committee.
- The Committee focussed on issues of heritage significance and context as set out and required in terms of Section.3.
- The Committee was divided on the significance of the building and its grading.
- Arguments not in favour of demolition were that the building has sufficient intrinsic significance by virtue of its intactness and its contribution to fine grained character of the inner core of the area. It was noted that the building has some local historical and architectural significance. The loss of the building would contribute to the further erosion of the fine grained character of the immediate area.
- Arguments in support of the application were that the building although substantially intact is of insufficient architectural, historical and aesthetic value or of rarity value. It is located within a much altered streetscape in which it plays little role in contributing to a heritage context. In light of this it is not possible to justify formal protection.
- Should HWC resolve to approve the demolition I&AP's have the option of approaching the City of Cape Town to exercise its powers to provisionally protect the site and therefore to take control of its future and provide time for negotiation around the creation of a heritage area under the Cape Town Zoning Scheme.

DECISION

The Committee resolved by a vote of the four to two to grade the building as IIIC.

The Committee resolved by a vote of three to three and the casting vote of the chairperson to approve the application.
