

MANAGING COVID-19 HOUSEHOLD WASTE.

SECURE ANY CONFIRMED OR SUSPECTED COVID-POSITIVE WASTE IN PLASTIC BAGS.

WHEN MOSTLY FULL, PLACE BAGS IN ANOTHER PLASTIC BAG AND TIE SECURELY.

SET BAGS ASIDE FOR 5 DAYS BEFORE COLLECTION.
