USE OF PROVINCIAL FUNDS TO BUY 2010 FIFA WORLD CUP TICKETS AND T-SHIRTS

Purpose

1. To inform provincial departments and entities of the implications of using provincial funds to buy 2010 FIFA World Cup tickets and t-shirts for Executives, VIP's and their spouses, and senior provincial officials.

Discussion

- 2. It has come to both the National and Provincial Treasury's attention that certain provincial departments are contemplating using public funds to buy 2010 FIFA World Cup tickets and t-shirts for Executives, VIP's and their spouses, and in some instances senior provincial officials. It has thus been deemed opportune to, at this stage, remind provincial departments and entities of the legislative implication of such spending.
- 3. In this regard, your attention is drawn to Chapter 1, section 2.3, of the Ministerial Handbook:

"Members may not:

- (c) use their position or any information entrusted to them, to enrich themselves or improperly benefit any other person;
- (e) expose themselves to any situation involving the risk of a conflict between their official responsibilities and their financial and/or personal interests:
- (g) make improper use of any allowance or payment properly made to them, or disregard the administrative rules, which apply to such allowances or payments."

4. You are also referred to section 38.(1) of the Public Finance Management Act (Act 1 of 1999) (PFMA) that, in the case of a payment authorised by the Accounting Officer of any department or state entity:

"The accounting officer for a department, trading entity or constitutional institution -

- (b) is responsible for the effective, efficient, economical and transparent use of the resources of the department, trading entity or constitutional institution;
- (c) must take effective steps to -
 - (ii) prevent unauthorised, irregular and fruitless and wasteful expenditure and losses resulting from criminal conduct."
- 5. Furthermore, sub-section 38.(2) of the PFMA stipulates that -

"An accounting officer may not commit a department, trading entity or constitutional institution to any liability for which money has not been appropriated."

6. In addition, section 24.(1)(a)(i) of the PFMA stipulates that

"Only a provincial treasury may withdraw money from a provincial revenue fund (PRF), and may do so only to provide funds that have been authorised in terms of an appropriation by a provincial Act; or as a direct charge against the PRF provided for in the Constitution or a provincial Act."

Conclusion

7. In view of the requirements of the PFMA, departments must please note that any diversion of funds towards the purchase of World Cup tickets and memorabilia for Executives, VIP's and their spouses, and senior provincial officials, will be considered as irregular expenditure. Accounting Officers who initiate such expenditure will thus be in violation of the PFMA, will be liable for a recovery of the relevant funds, and will have committed an act of financial misconduct in terms of section 81 of the PFMA.
