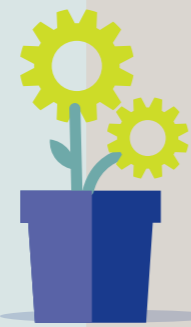
Bursaries

2 staff members received staff bursaries



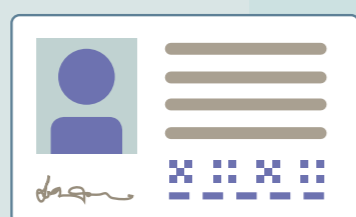

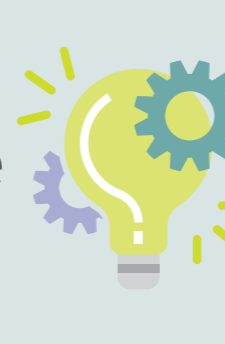

5 333 active vehicles in the fleet

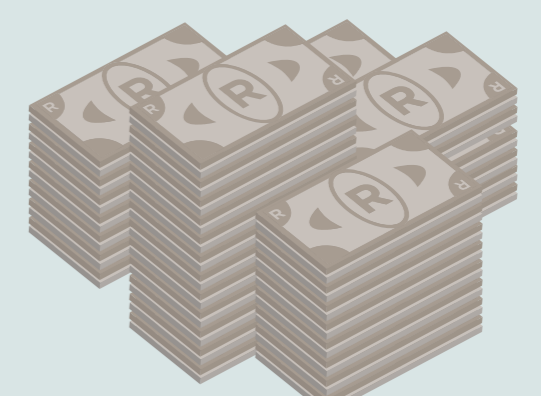


3 994 vehicles travel more than 1 000 kilometres per month

47% of approved budget for replacement vehicles was spent



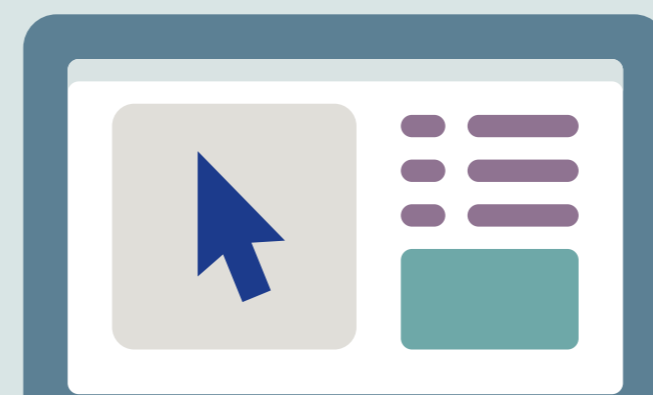
6 698 vehicle inspections were carried out
