

- Demographic data included




REPRESENTATION PER STAKEHOLDER GROUP


REPRESENTATION PER PRECINCT



Police station or Precinct [79 voters]




REPRESENTATION PER GENDER











3. If you were a victim of crime in the last 3 years, did you report it to the police? Aggregate Results [77 votes]






4. When you reported a crime to SAPS, they arrived at the crime scene on average: Aggregate Results [78 votes]





5. When you phoned the police station, how long on average did it take for your call to be answered? Aggregate Results [77 votes]







6. When you go to your local police station, on average, how long do you have to wait before you are attended to? Aggregate Results [79 votes]













8. If you have ever opened a case with the police, how often on average did the police provide you with progress reports on their Aggregate Results [79 votes]






9. During the last week, when did you see SAPS patrolling your area? Aggregate Results [78 votes]








11. How do you rate the level of professionalism of SAPS in your area? Aggregate Results [78 votes]














14. If you are involved in partnerships against crime, please indicate the 3 formations/structures you are most actively involved in Aggregate Results [164 votes]
















16. Do you think that police resources are being utilized effectively / optimally at your local station? Aggregate Results [75 votes]












18. In your opinion, how would you rate the effectiveness of the witness protection programme? Aggregate Results [77 votes]




20. In your opinion, what is the main contributor of crime? (possible causes) Aggregate Results [76 votes]






21. In your opinion, what is the main motivator of crime? Aggregate Results [75 votes]






22. In your opinion, what is the main oppportunity for crime in your area? Aggregate Results [75 votes]






23. Identify the areas where you feel most unsafe Aggregate Results [206 votes]






24. Identify the time you feel most unsafe in your area Aggregate Results [74 votes]






25. When would you like to see improved police visibility in your area? Aggregate Results [73 votes]






26. Please select the 3 key safety needs in your opinion Aggregate Results [211 votes]
