

- Demographic data included













## 1. Do you know in which police sector you reside? Aggregate Results [41 votes]






## 2. Were you a victim of crime in the: Aggregate Results [41 votes]






## 3. If you were a victim of crime in the last 3 years, did you report it to the police? Aggregate Results [41 votes]






4. When you reported a crime to SAPS, they arrived at the crime scene on average: Aggregate Results [41 votes]






5. When you phoned the police station, how long on average did it take for your call to be answered? Aggregate Results [41 votes]






# 6. When you go to your local police station, on average, how long do you have to wait before you are attended to? Aggregate Results [41 votes]






## 7. The last time you visited your local police station, were you served in the language of your choice being either isiXhosa, English or Afrikaans Aggregate Results [41 votes]






8. If you have ever opened a case with the police, how often on average did the police provide you with progress reports on their Aggregate Results [41 votes]






## 9. During the last week, when did you see SAPS patrolling your area? Aggregate Results [41 votes]






## 10. Do you know who your local police station commander is? Aggregate Results [41 votes]






## 11. How do you rate the level of professionalism of SAPS in your area? Aggregate Results [41 votes]






## 12. In your opinion, how professional is the provision of victim support / counselling services at your local police station? Aggregate Results [41 votes]






# 13. If you have ever received counselling via victim support services, how professionally was your referral handled? Aggregate Results [41 votes]






## 14. If you are involved in partnerships against crime, please indicate the 3 formations/structures you are most actively involved in Aggregate Results [100 votes]






# 15. Do you think there are enough police resources (e.g. police officers, equipment etc) for your community? Aggregate Results [41 votes]






## 16. Do you think that police resources are being utilized effectively / optimally at your local station? Aggregate Results [41 votes]












19. Which 3 priority crimes must SAPS focus on in your area? Aggregate Results [109 votes]








## 20. In your opinion, what is the main contributor of crime? (possible causes) Aggregate Results [41 votes]














## 24. Identify the time you feel most unsafe in your area Aggregate Results [41 votes]






### 25. When would you like to see improved police visibility in your area? Aggregate Results [41 votes]






#### 26. Please select the 3 key safety needs in your opinion Aggregate Results [115 votes]
