

- Demographic data included








#### 3. If you were a victim of crime in the last 3 years, did you report it to the police? Aggregate Results [120 votes]






4. When you reported a crime to SAPS, they arrived at the crime scene on average: Aggregate Results [126 votes]






5. When you phoned the police station, how long on average did it take for your call to be answered? Aggregate Results [123 votes]










20. In your opinion, what is the main contributor of crime? (possible causes) Aggregate Results [128 votes]






21. In your opinion, what is the main motivator of crime? Aggregate Results [124 votes]






22. In your opinion, what is the main oppportunity for crime in your area? Aggregate Results [126 votes]






23. Identify the areas where you feel most unsafe Aggregate Results [351 votes]






#### 24. Identify the time you feel most unsafe in your area Aggregate Results [123 votes]






25. When would you like to see improved police visibility in your area? Aggregate Results [125 votes]






