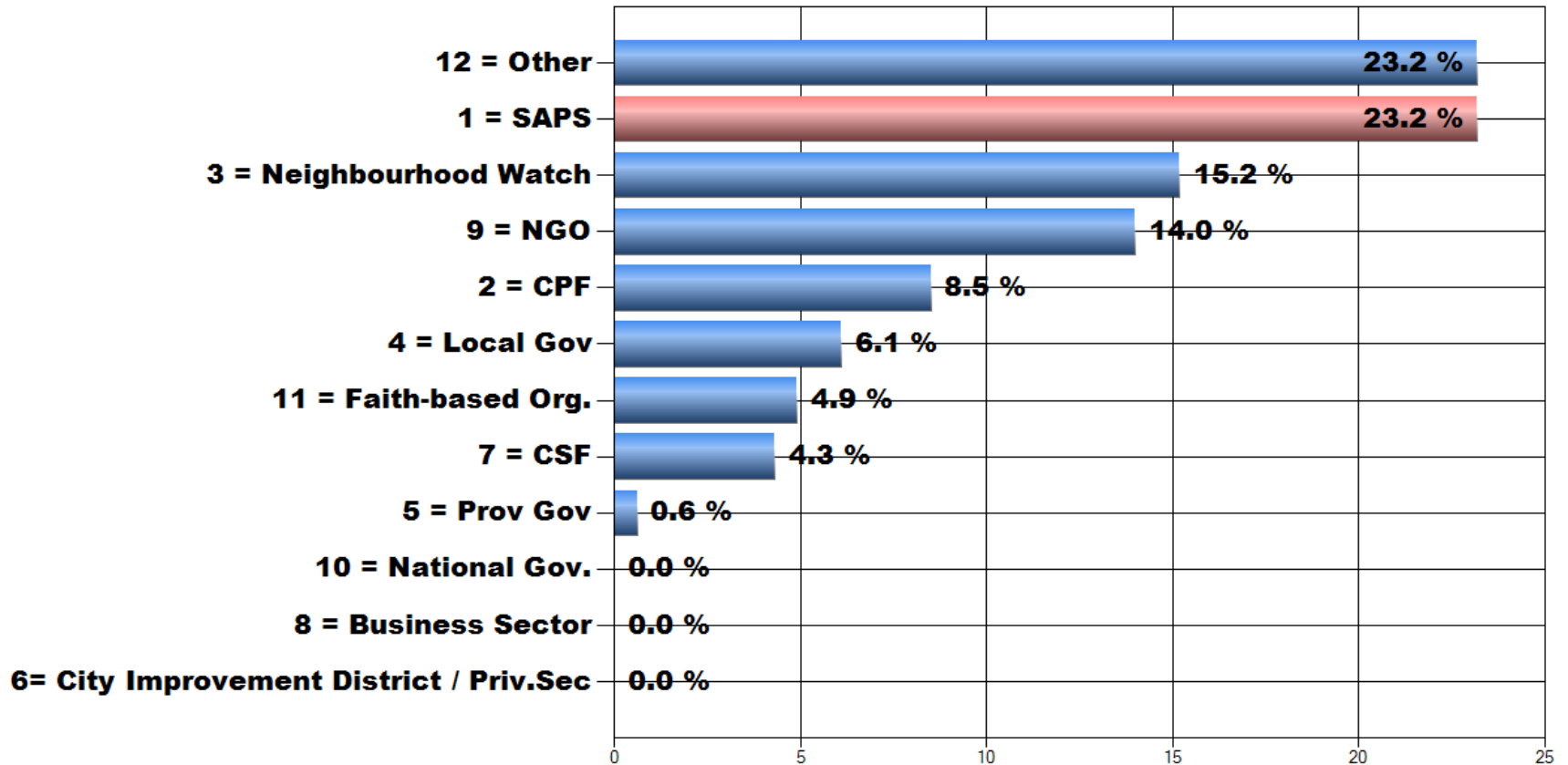

- Demographic data included

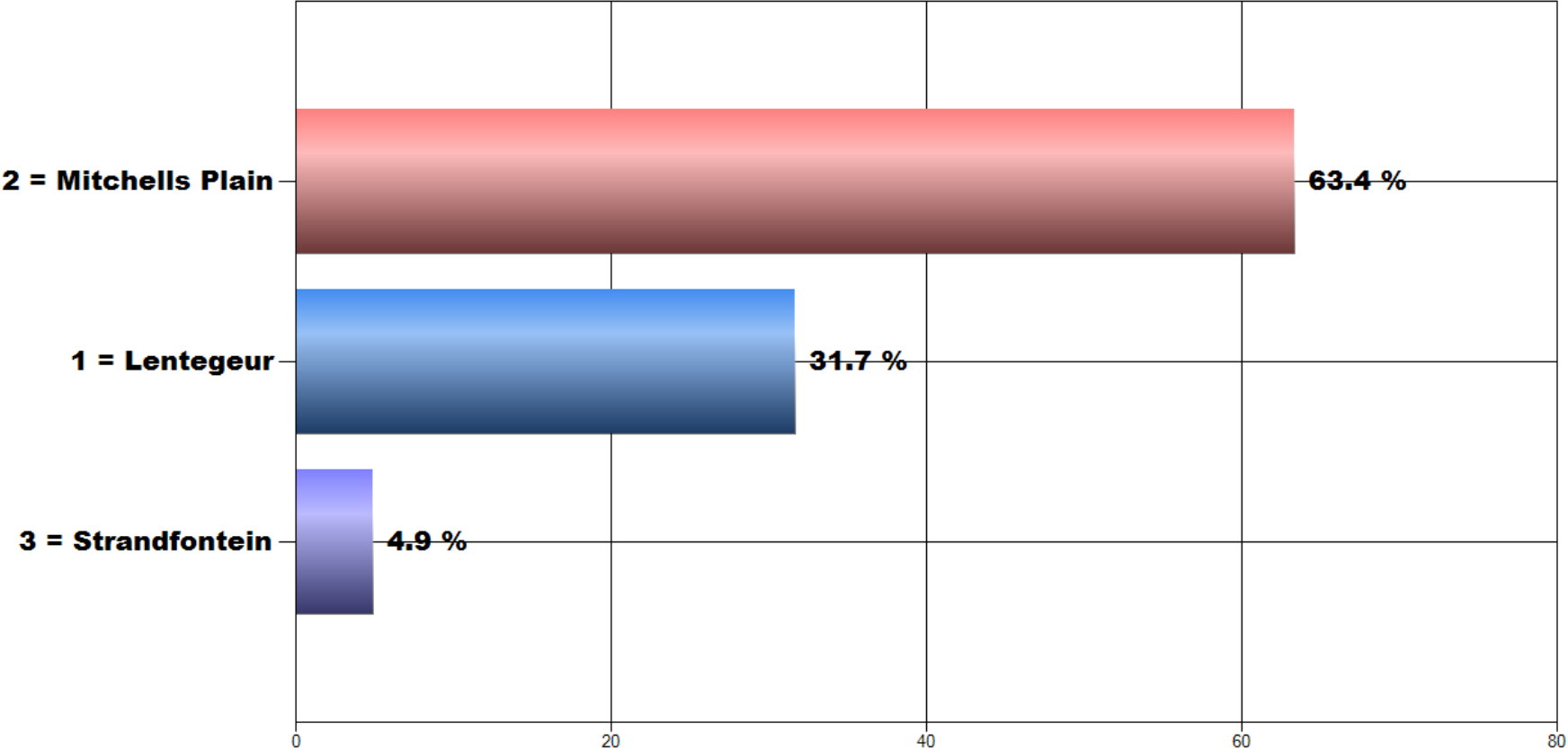

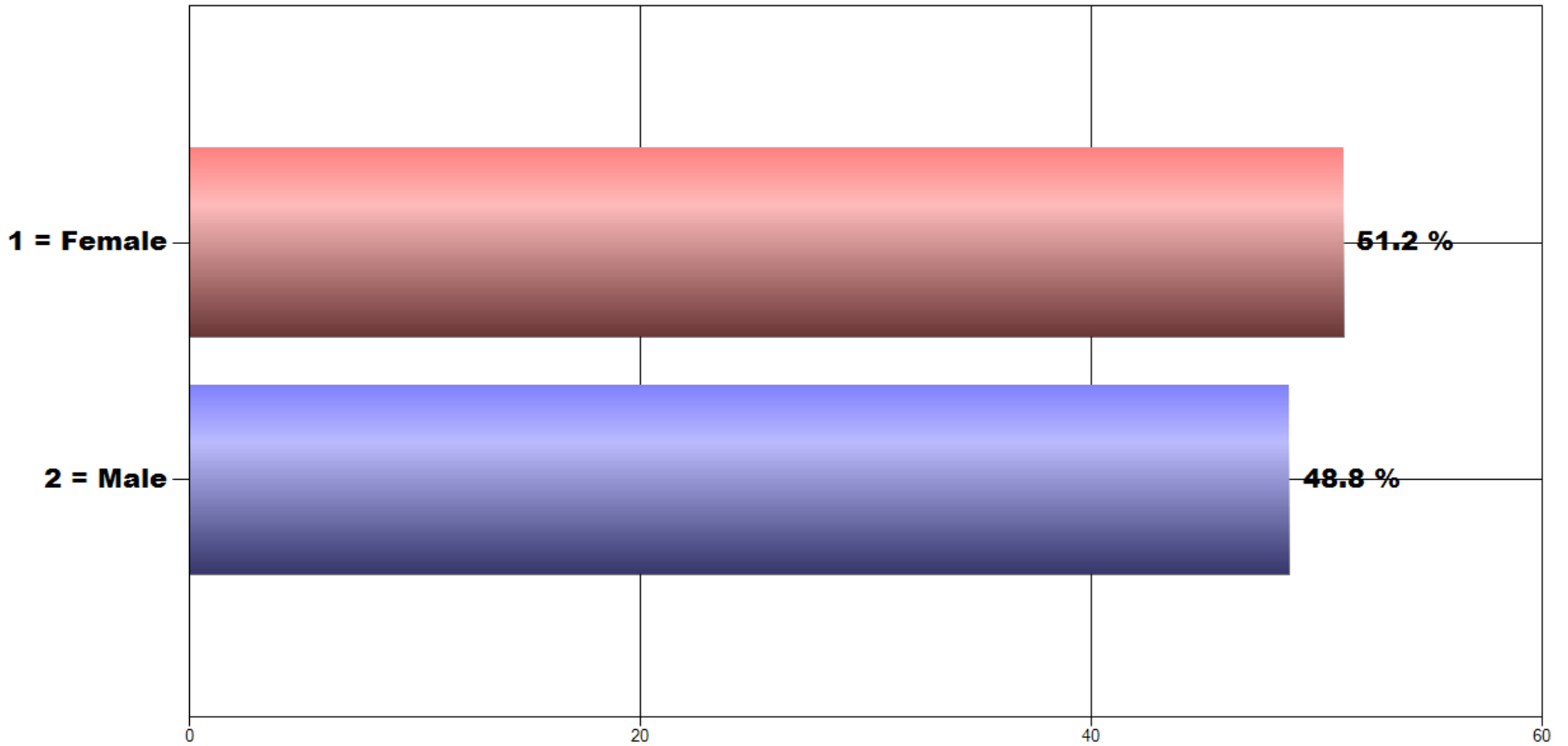


REPRESENTATION PER PRECINCT

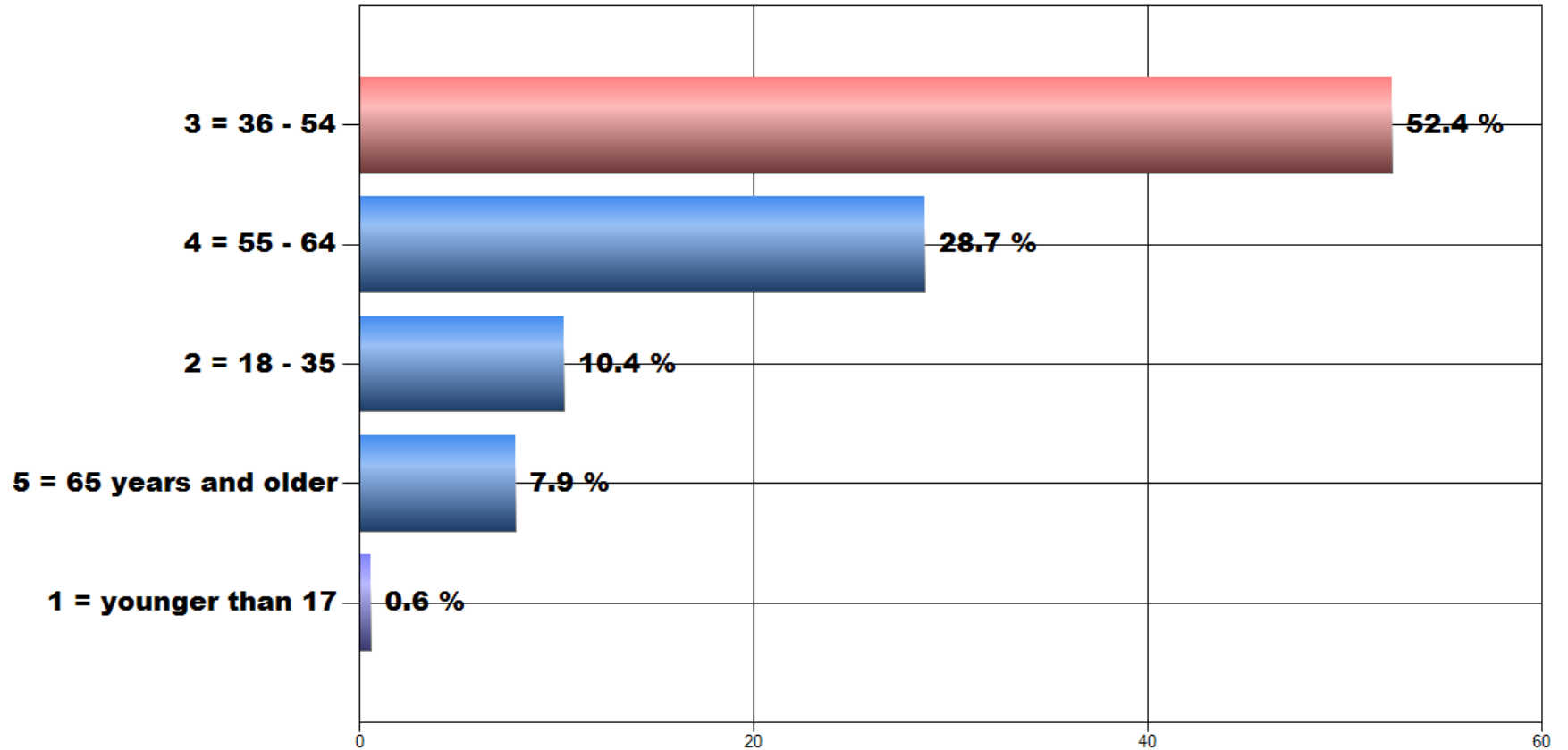
Police station or Precinct [164 voters]



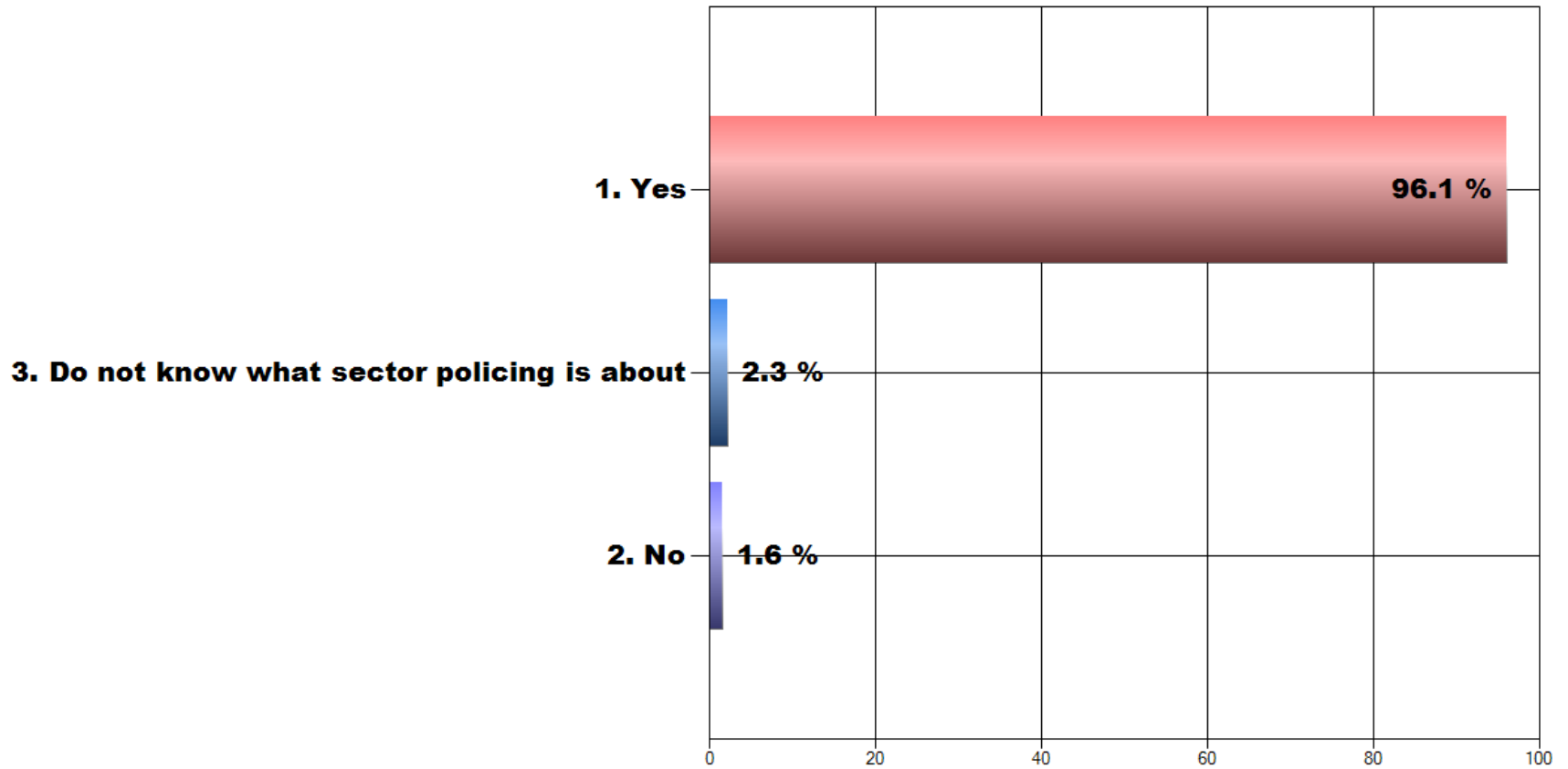
Gender [164 voters]



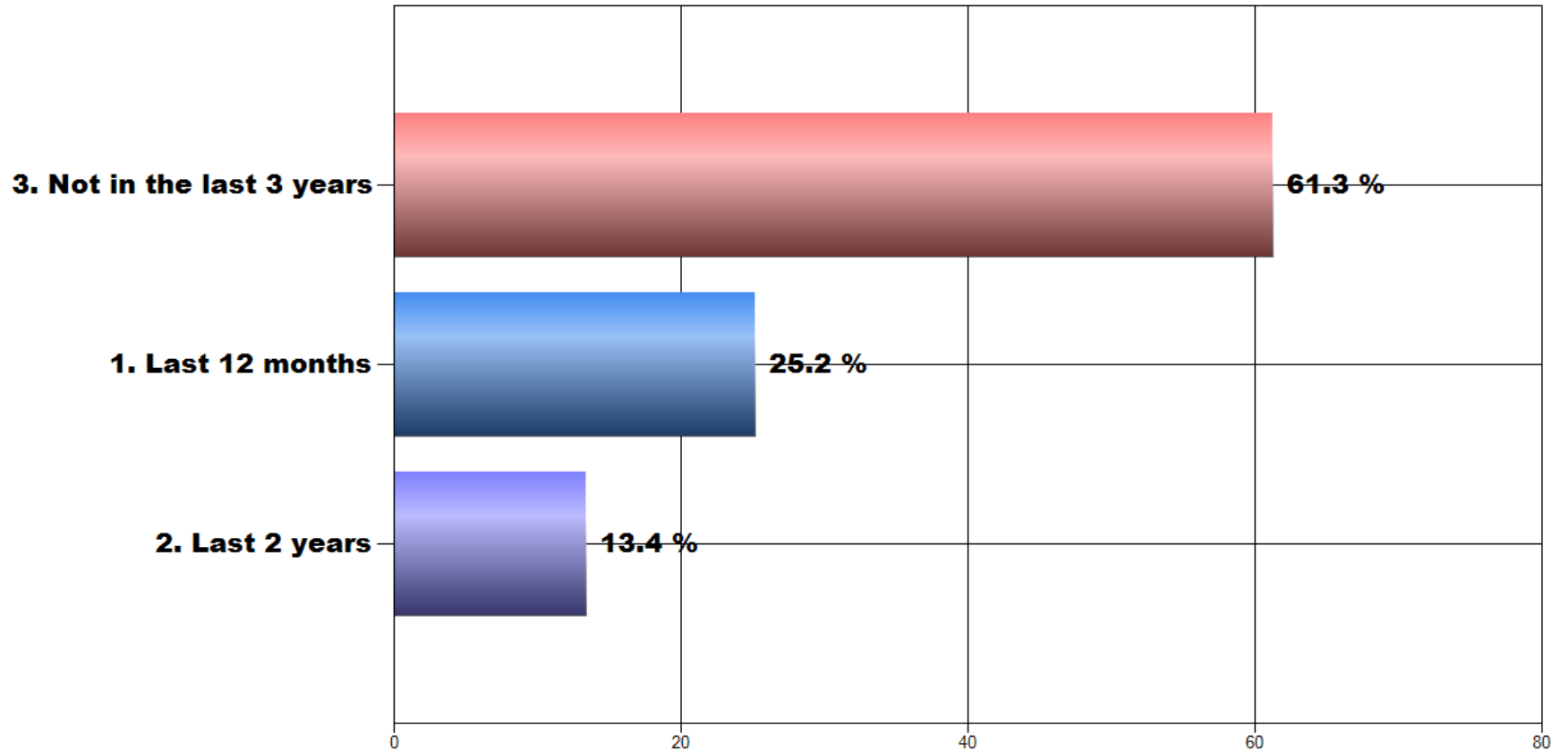

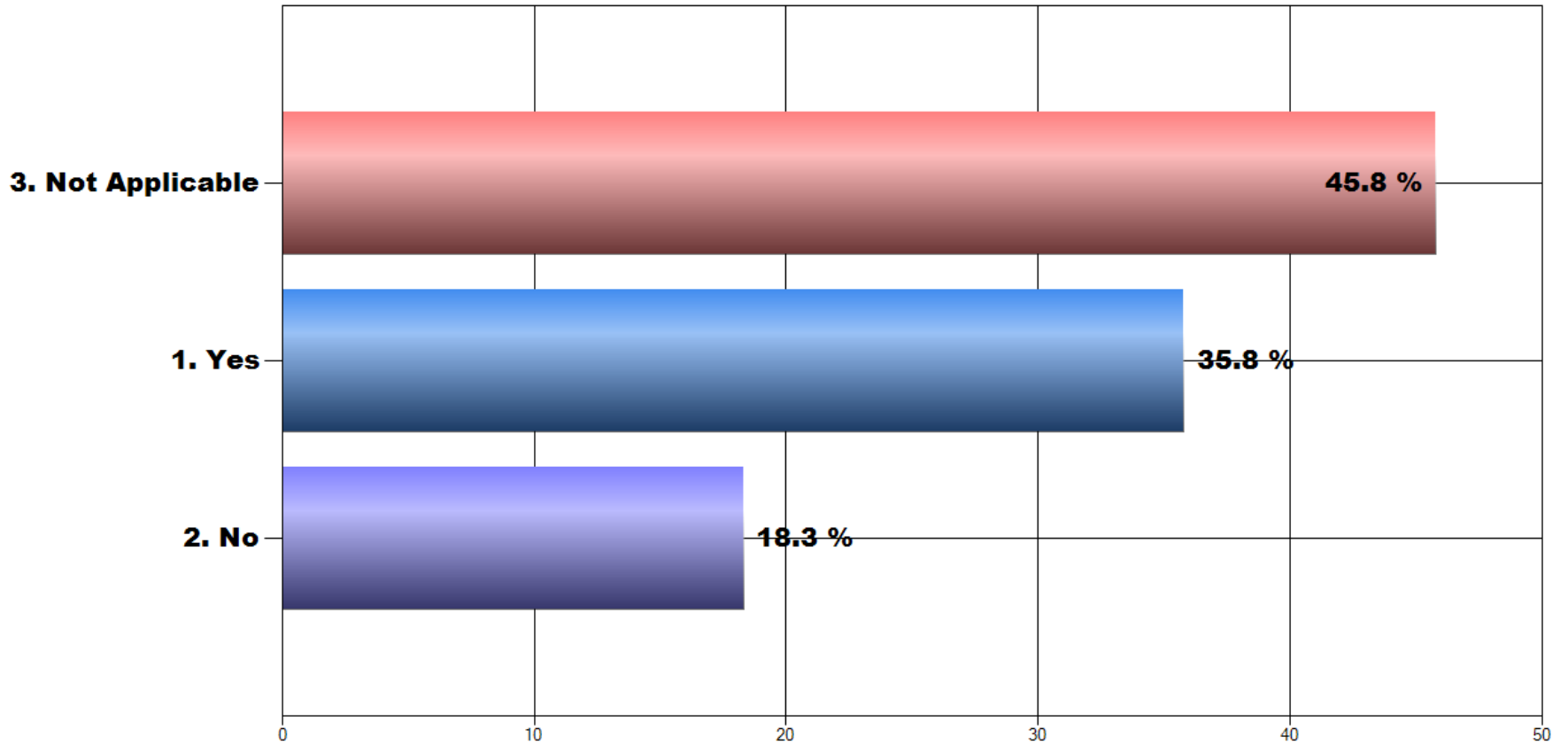

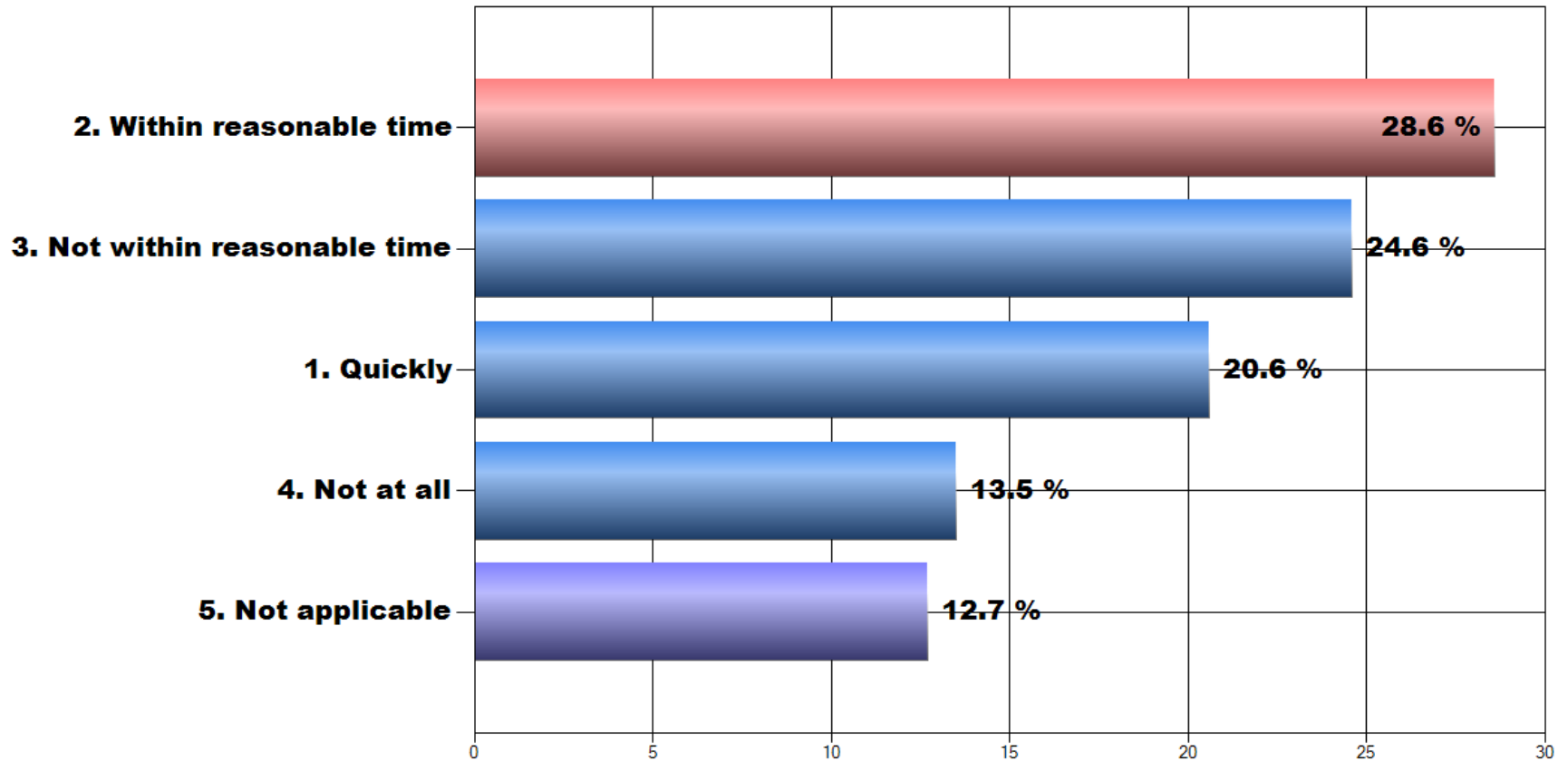

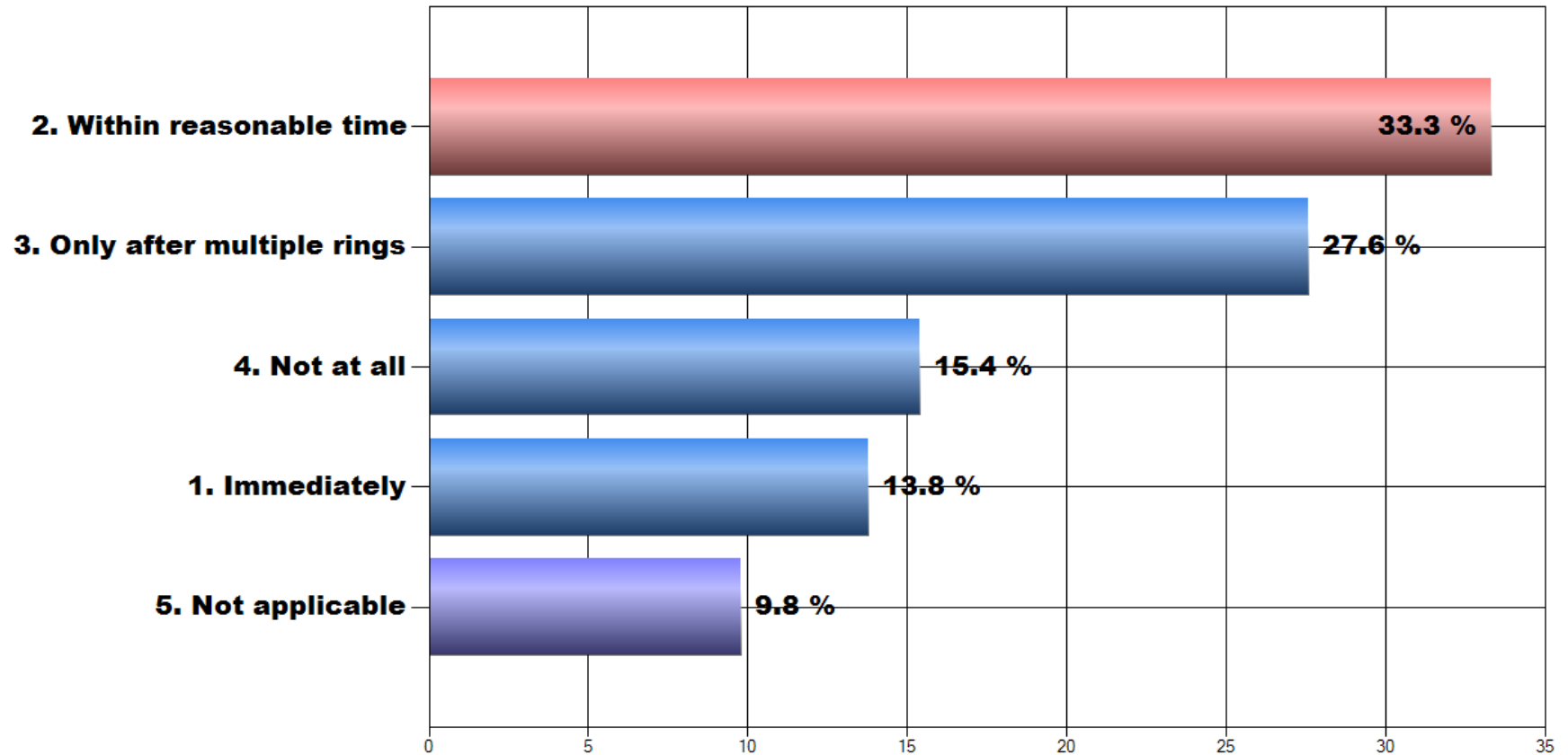
3. If you were a victim of crime in the last 3 years, did you report it to the police? Aggregate Results [120 votes]



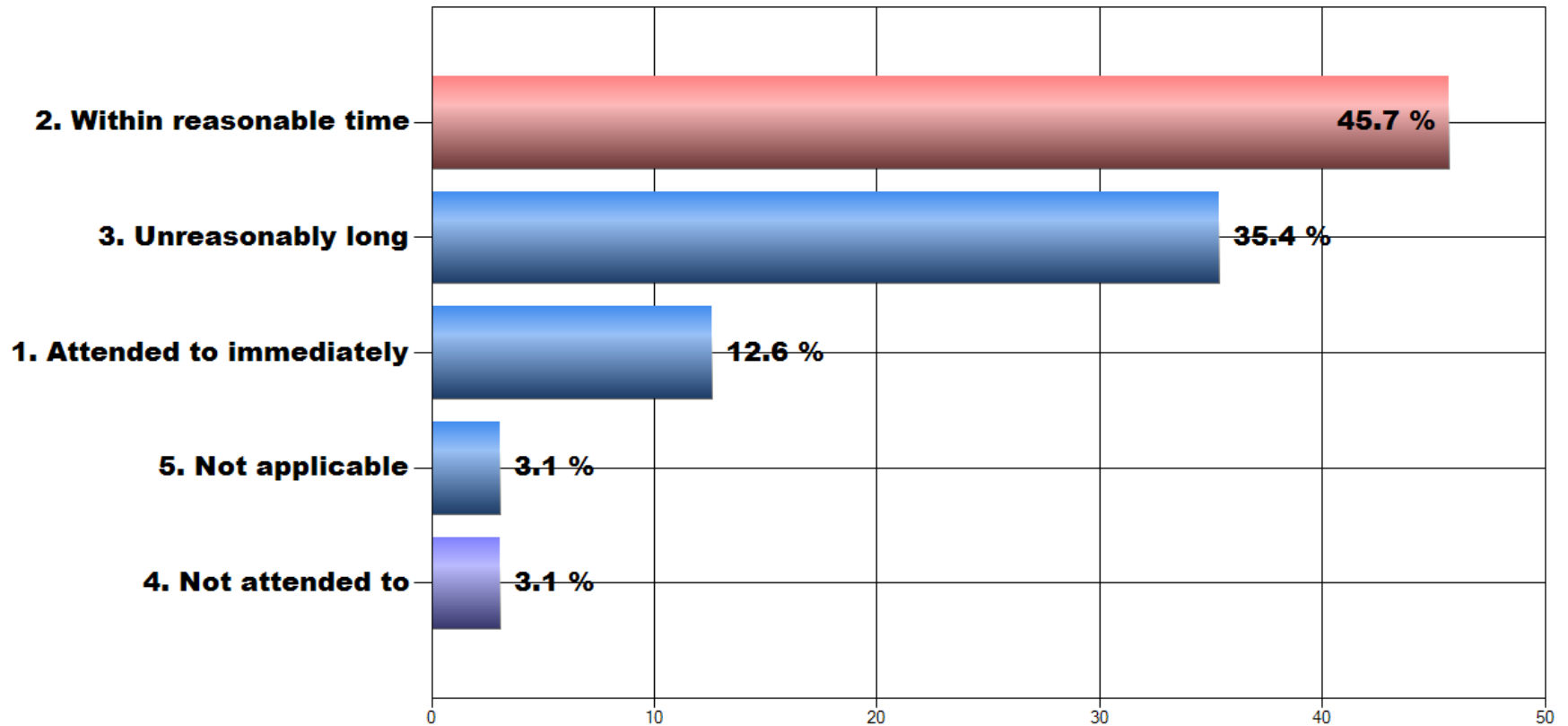
4. When you reported a crime to SAPS, they arrived at the crime scene on average: Aggregate Results [126 votes]



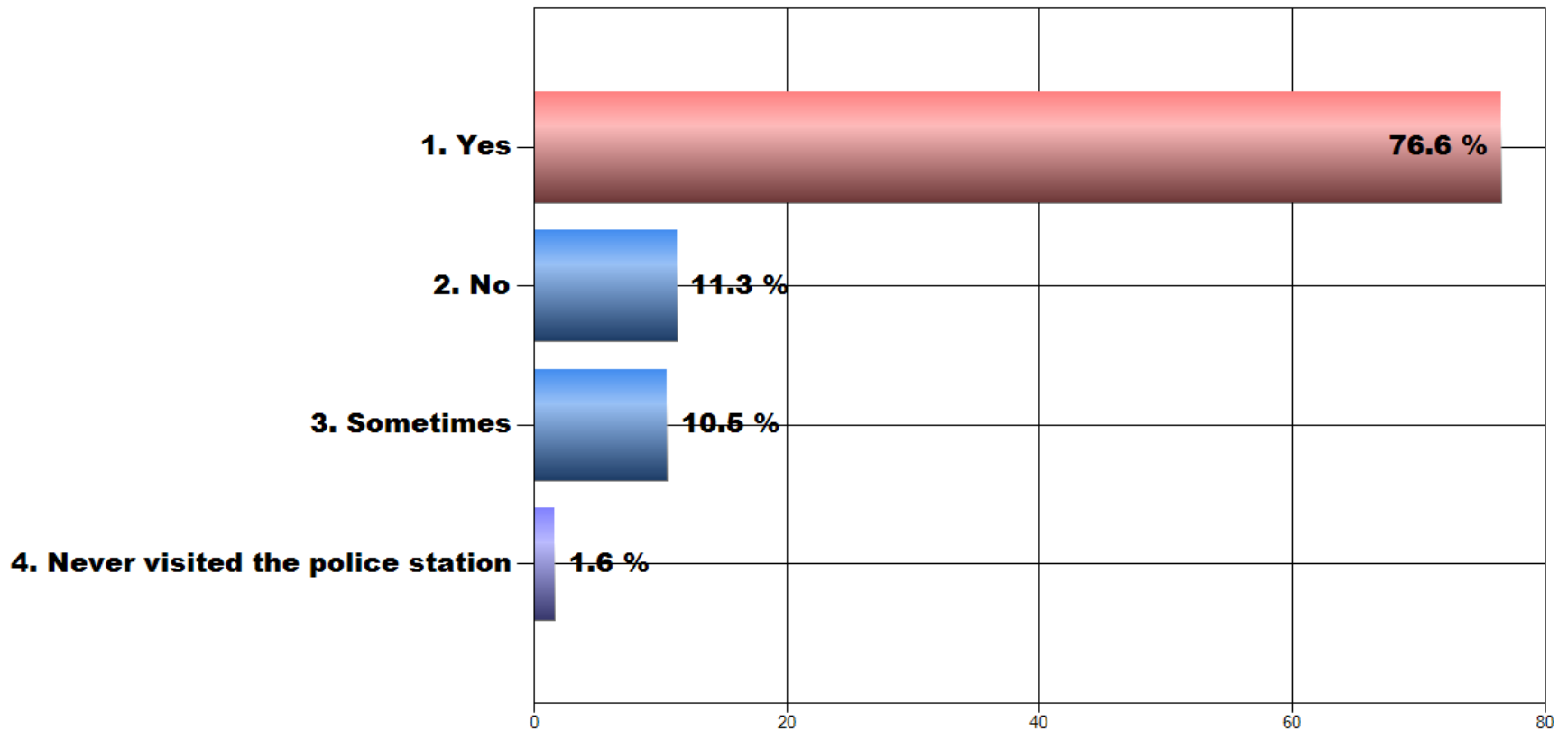

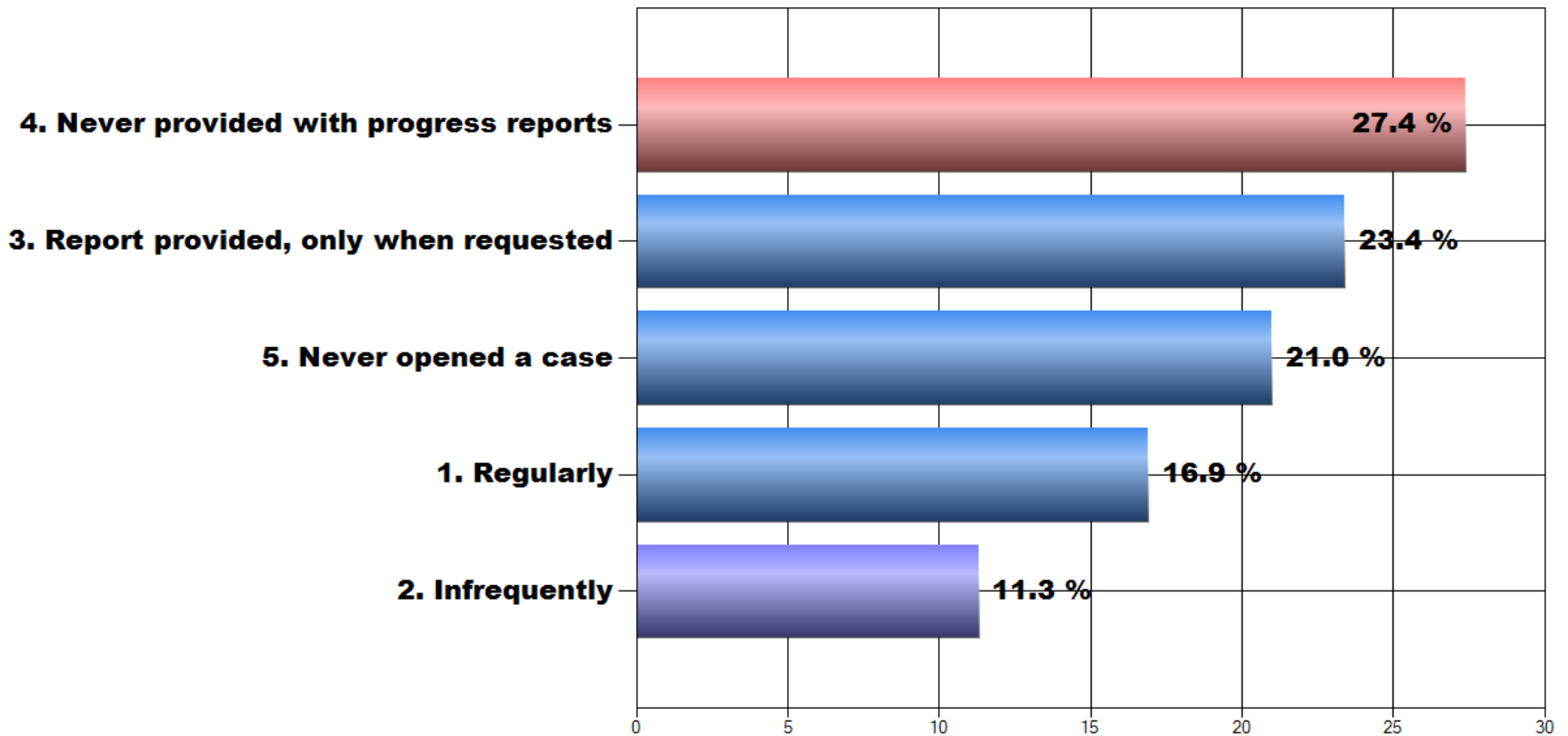

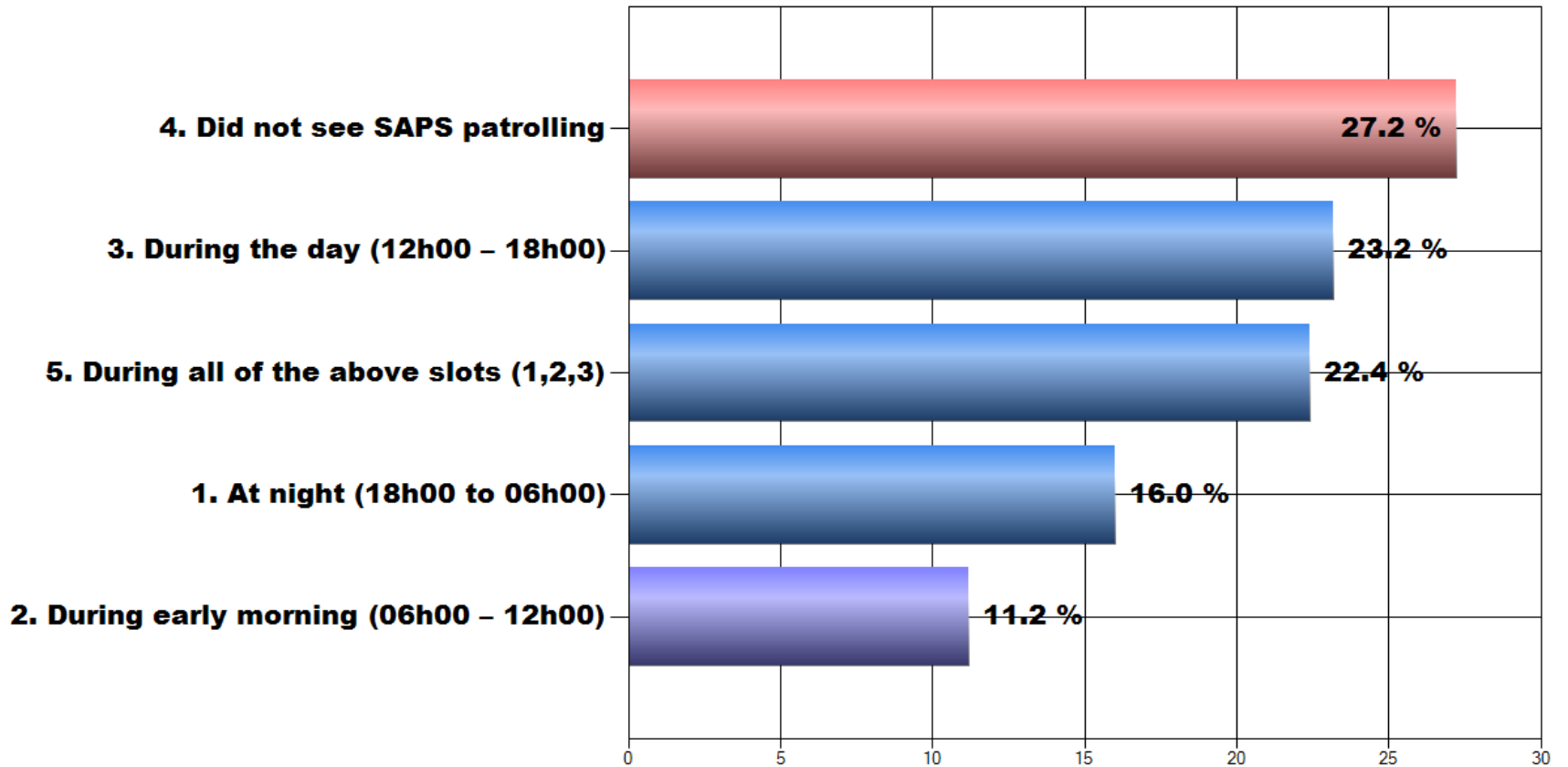

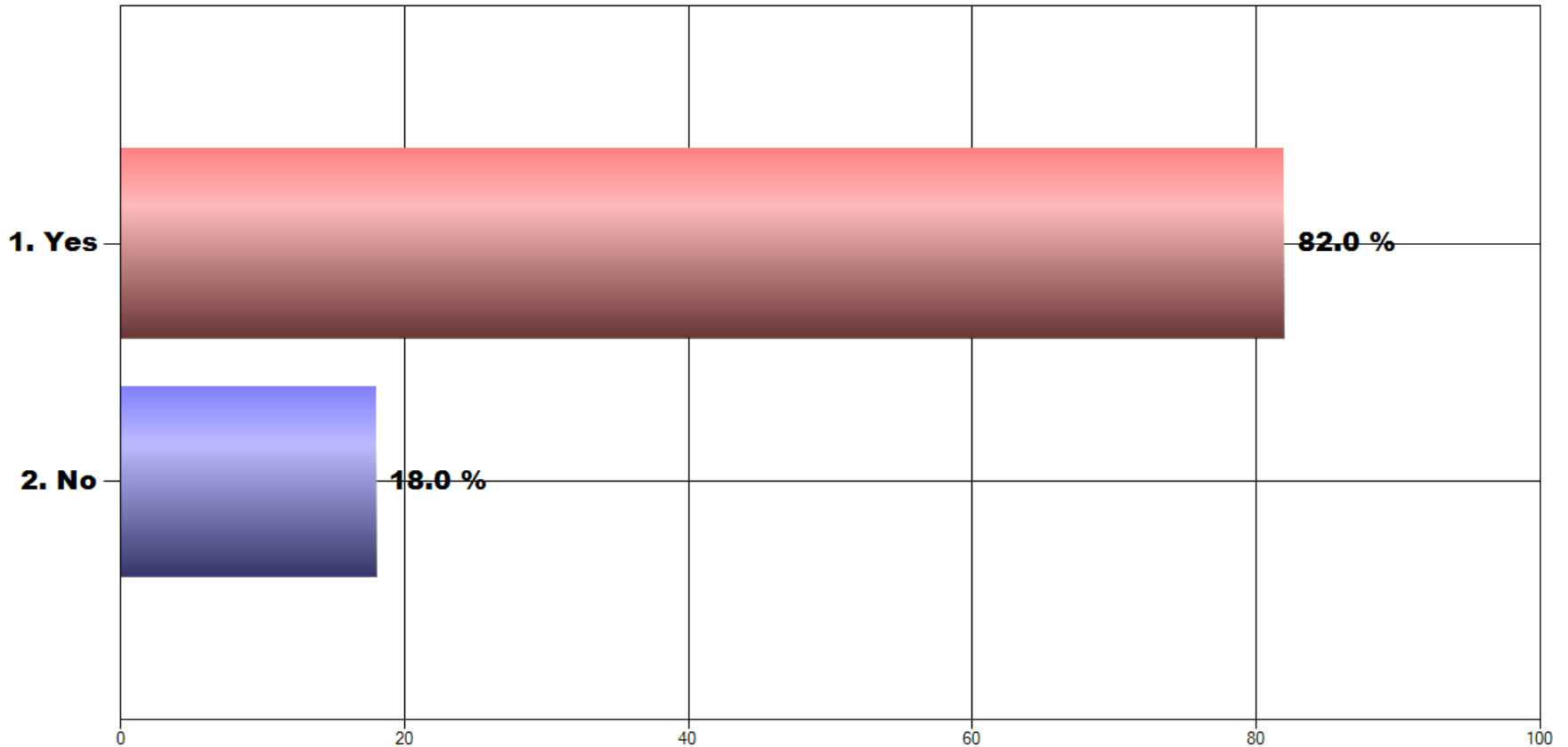

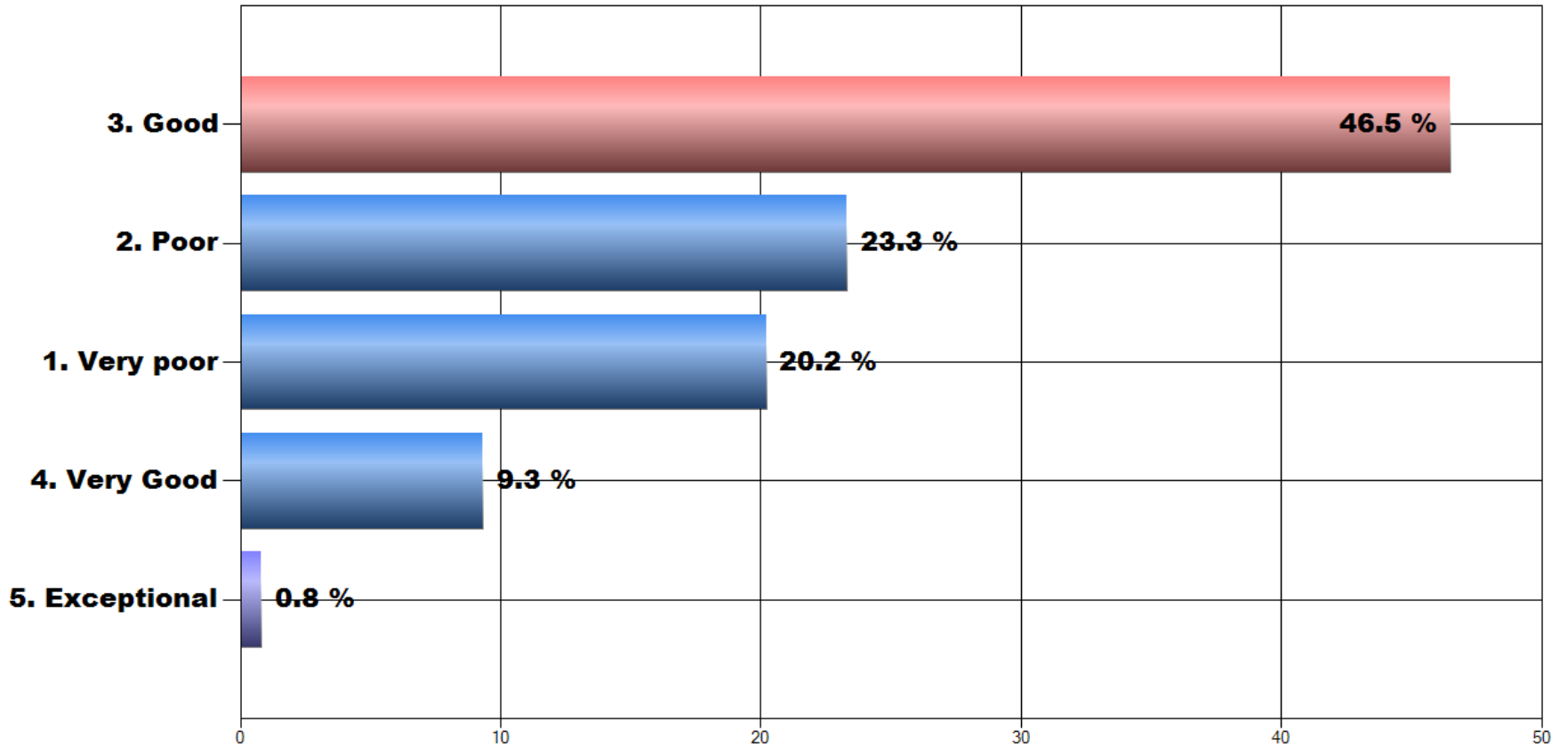

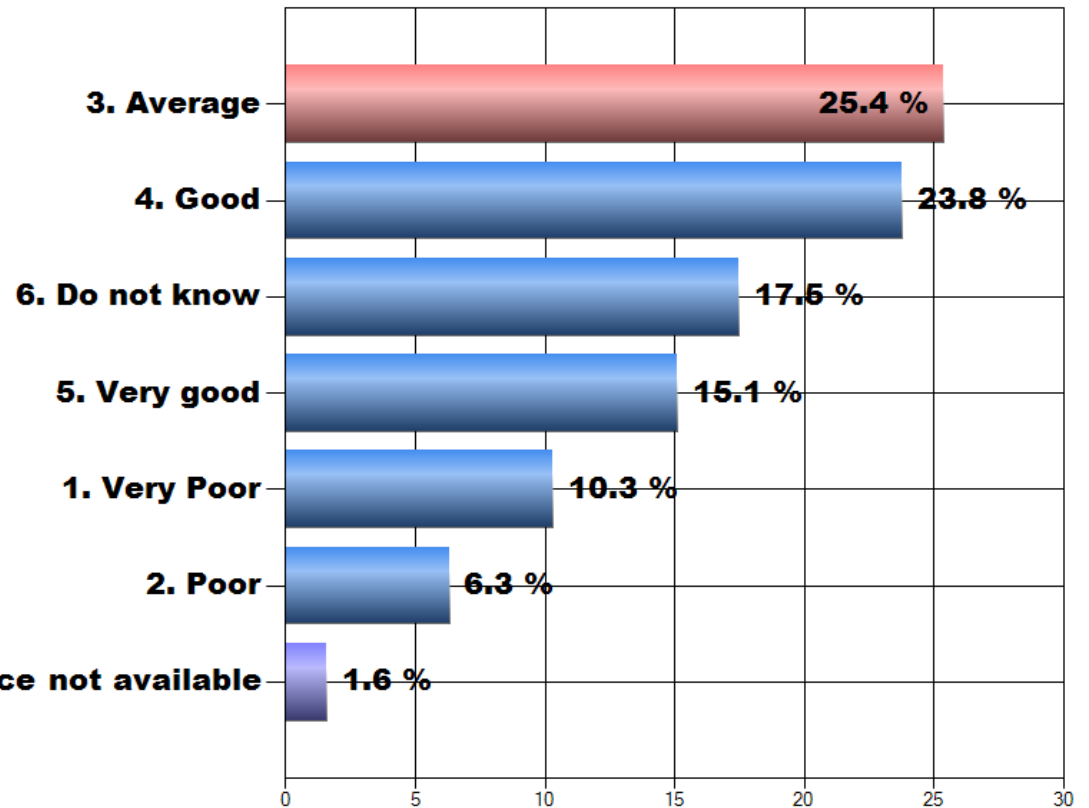

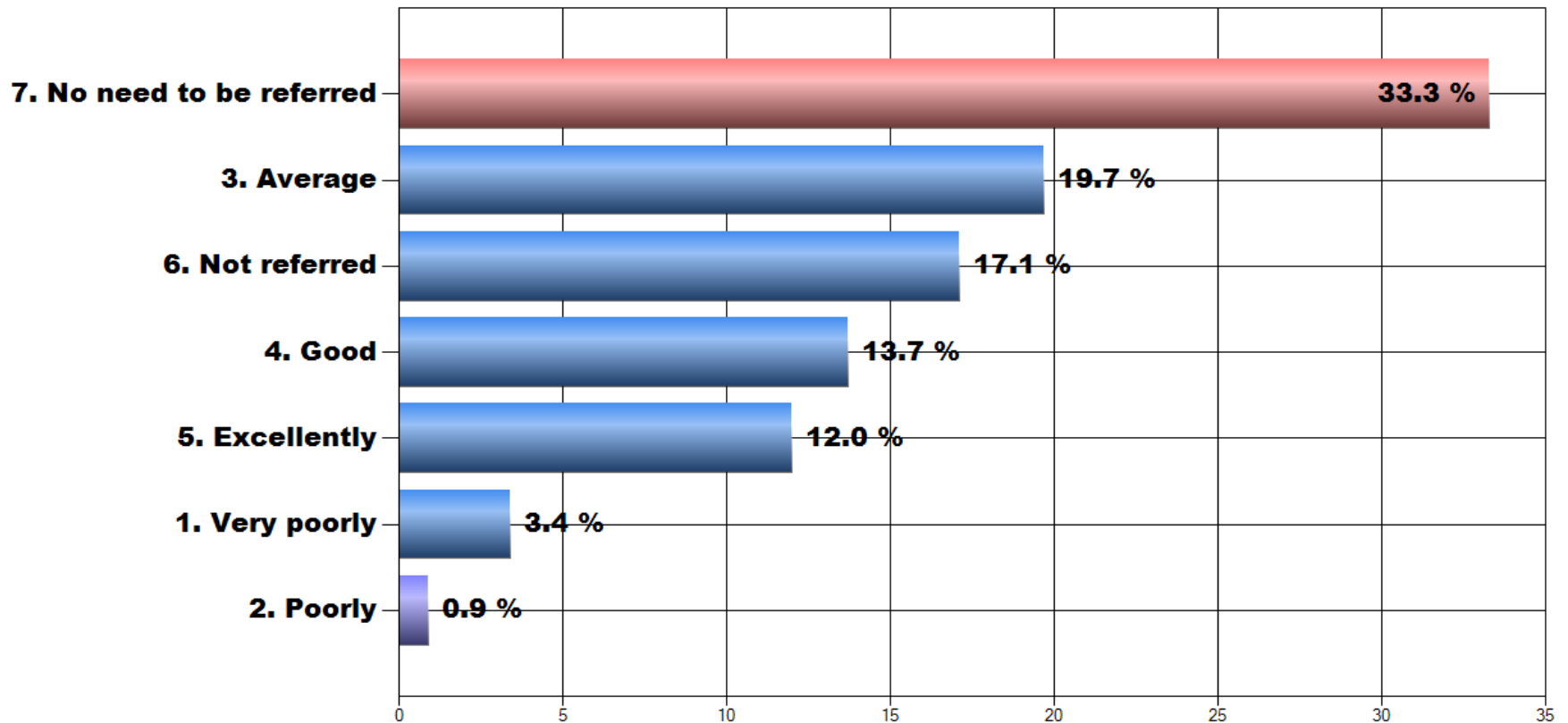

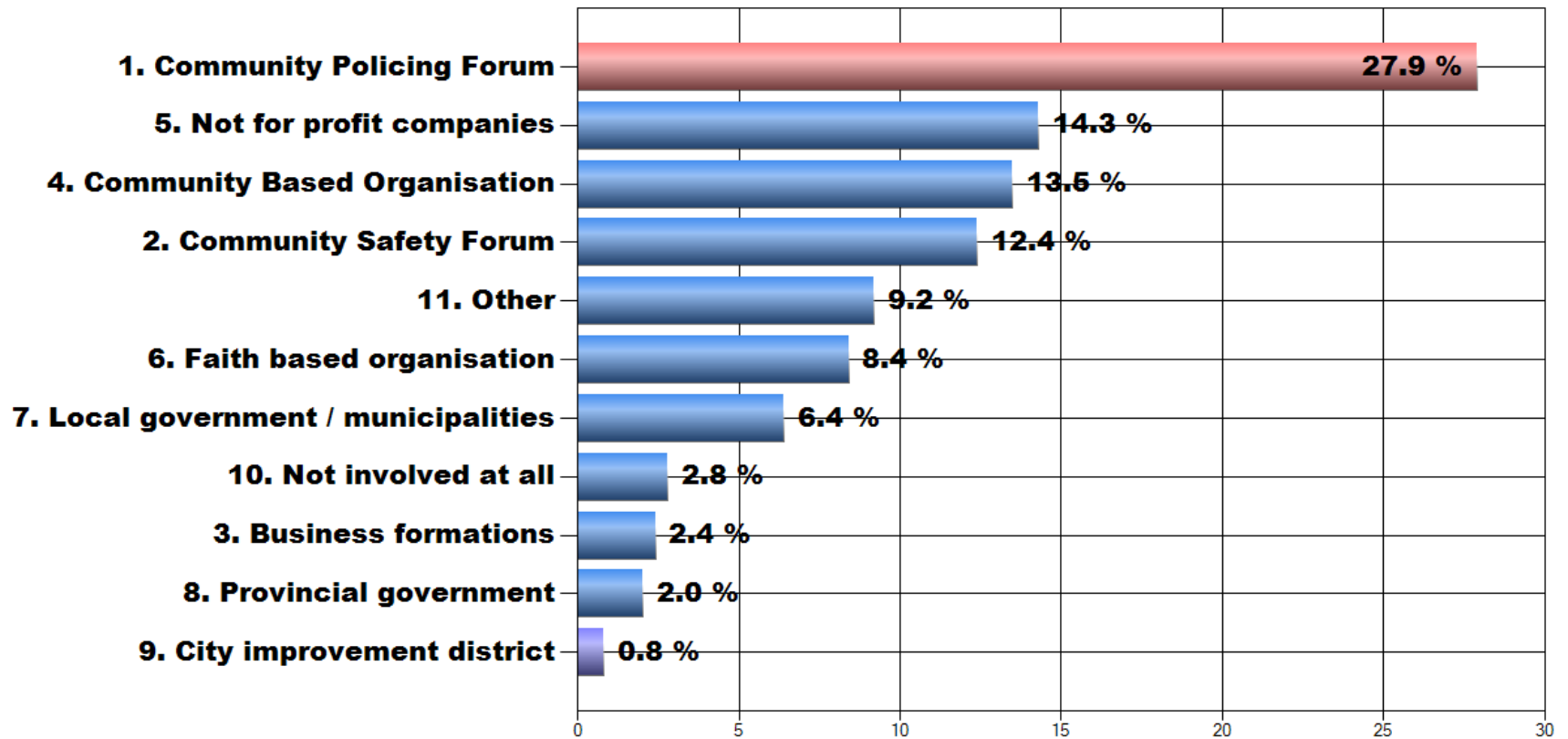

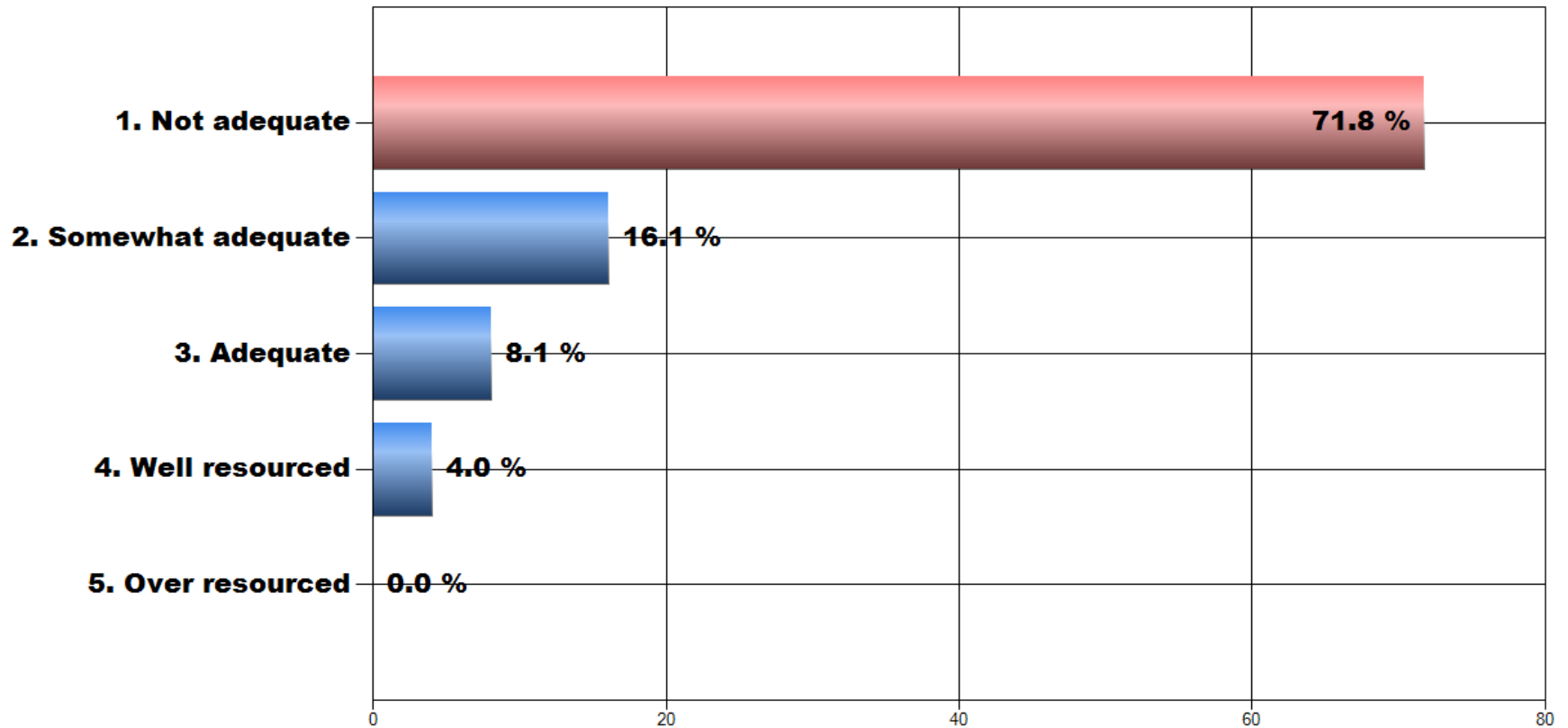

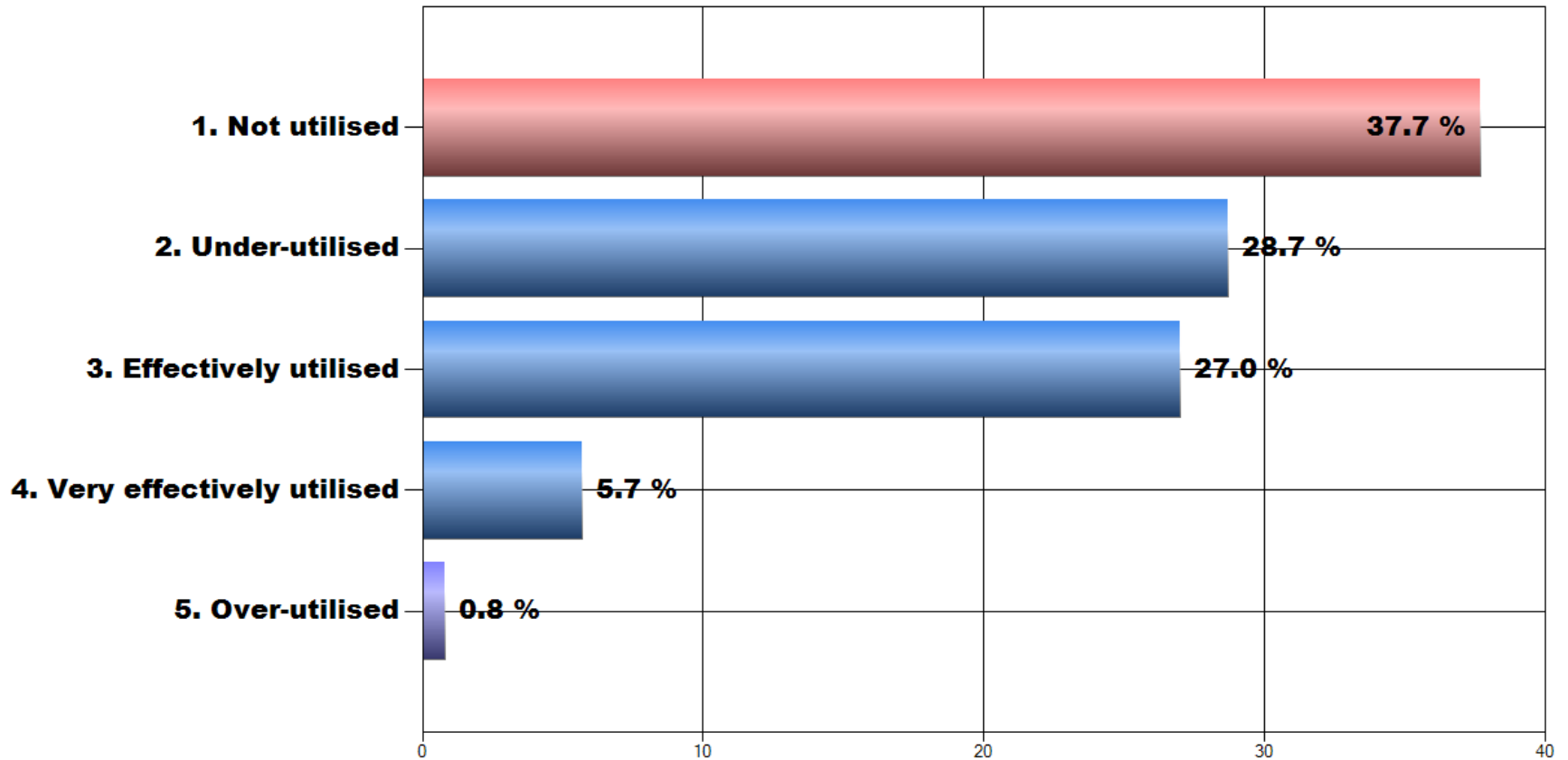
14. If you are involved in partnerships against crime, please indicate the 3 formations/structures you are most actively involved in

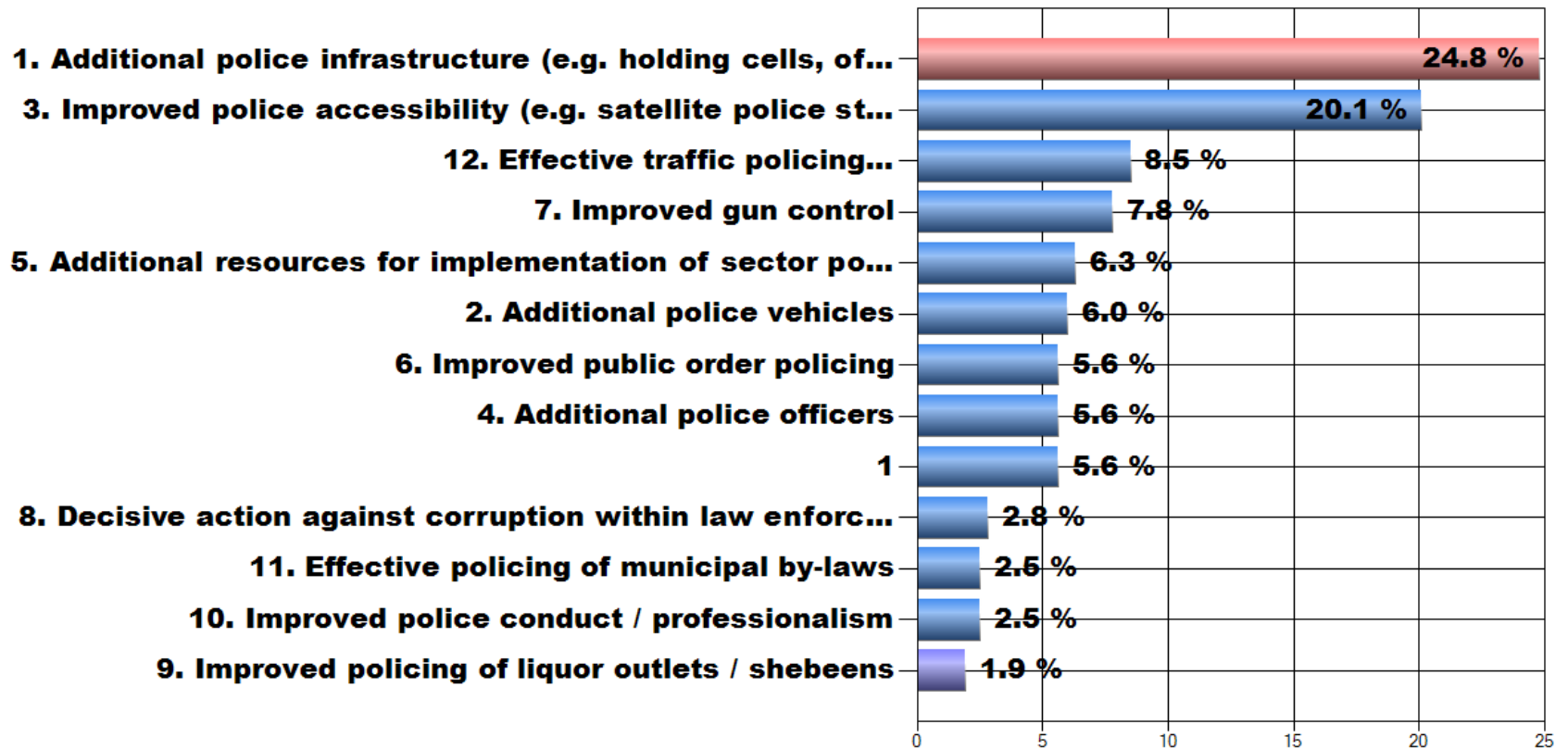

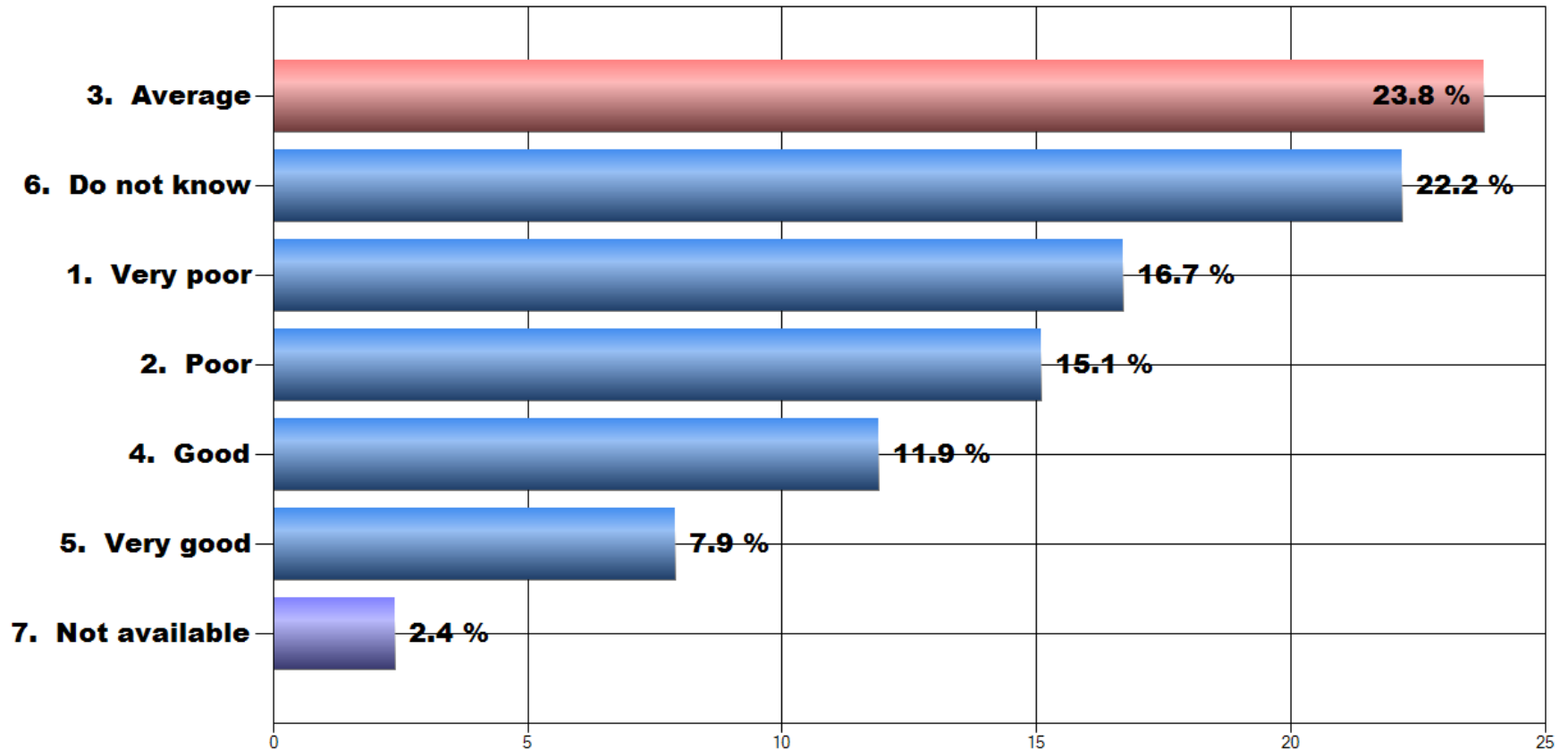

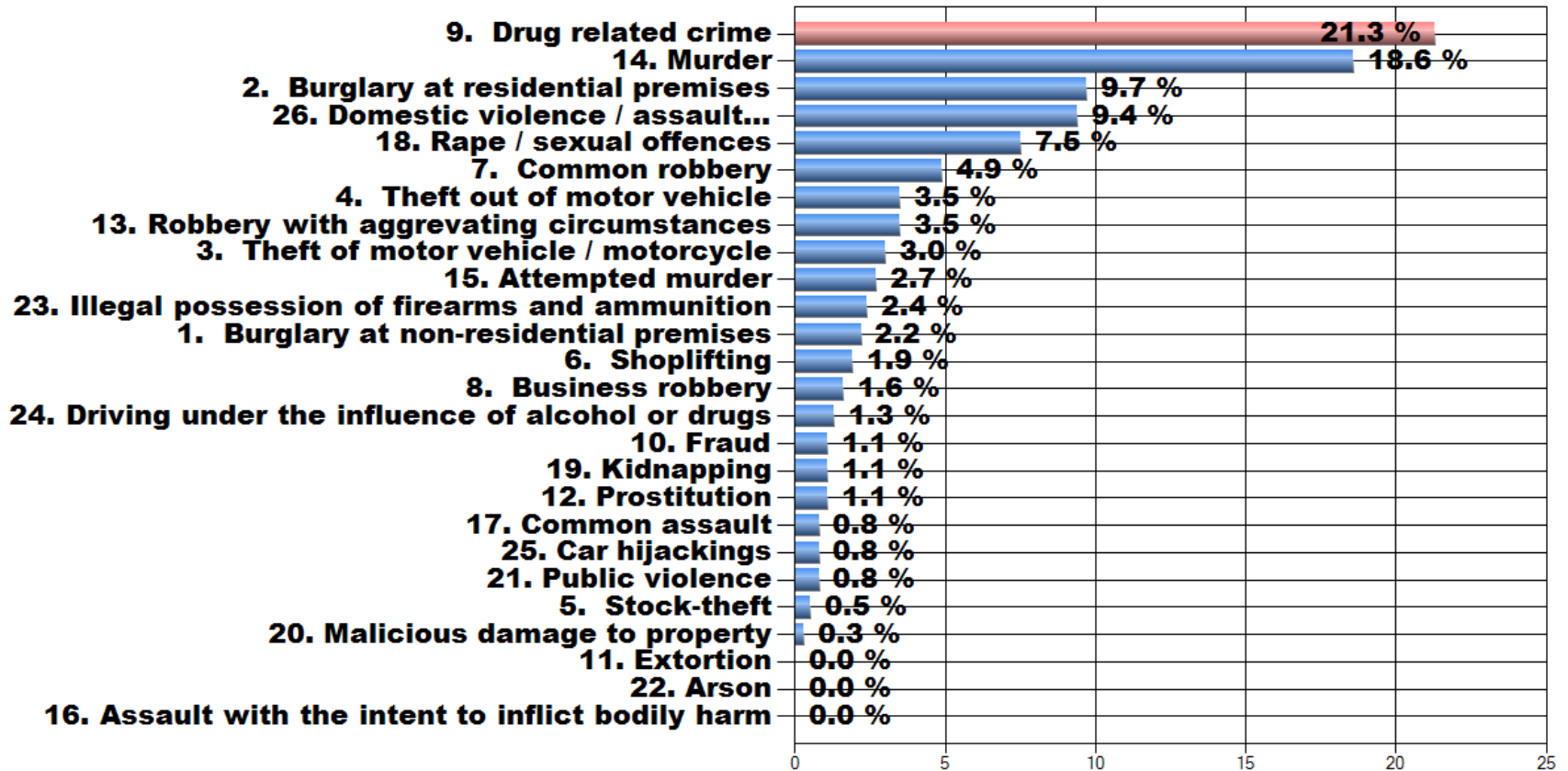

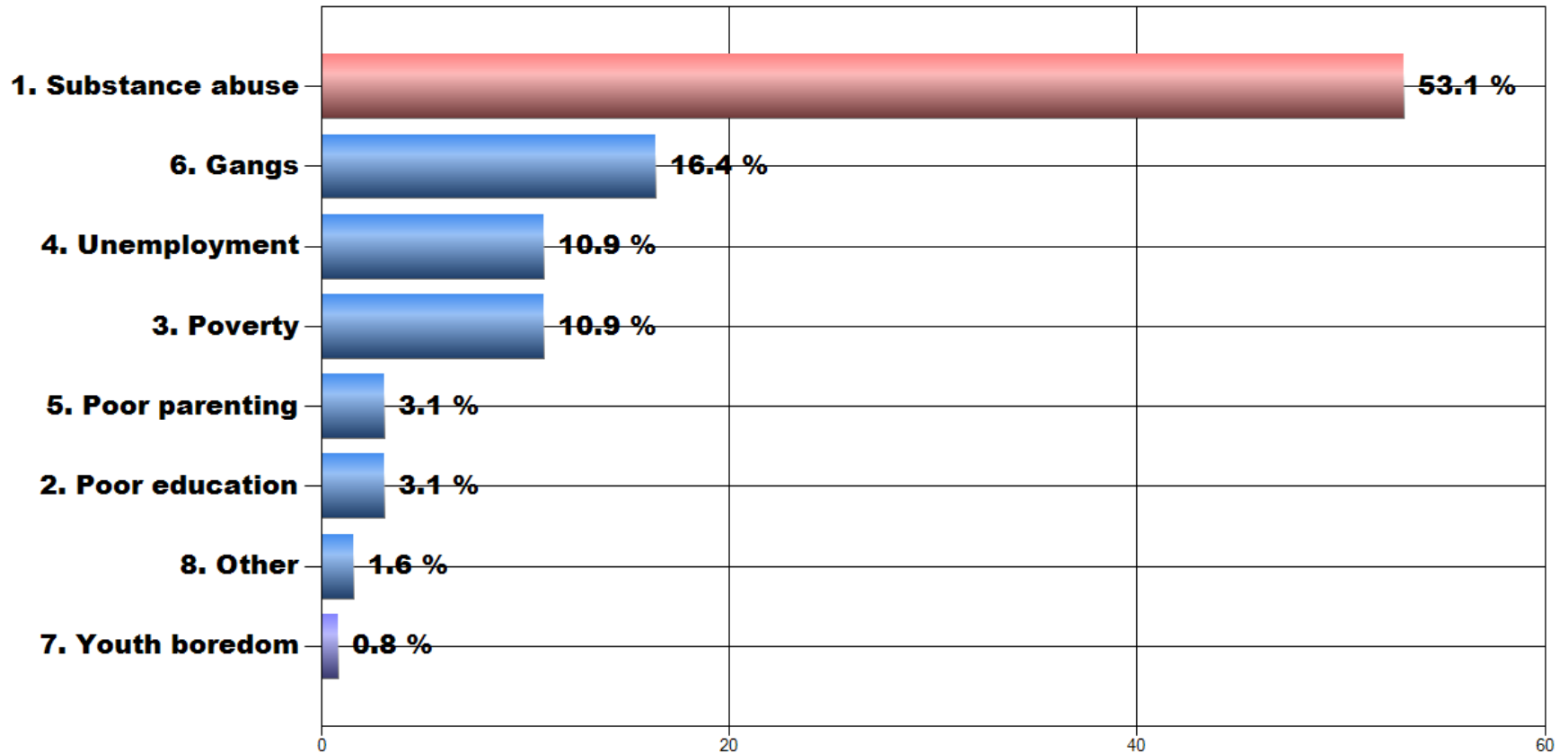

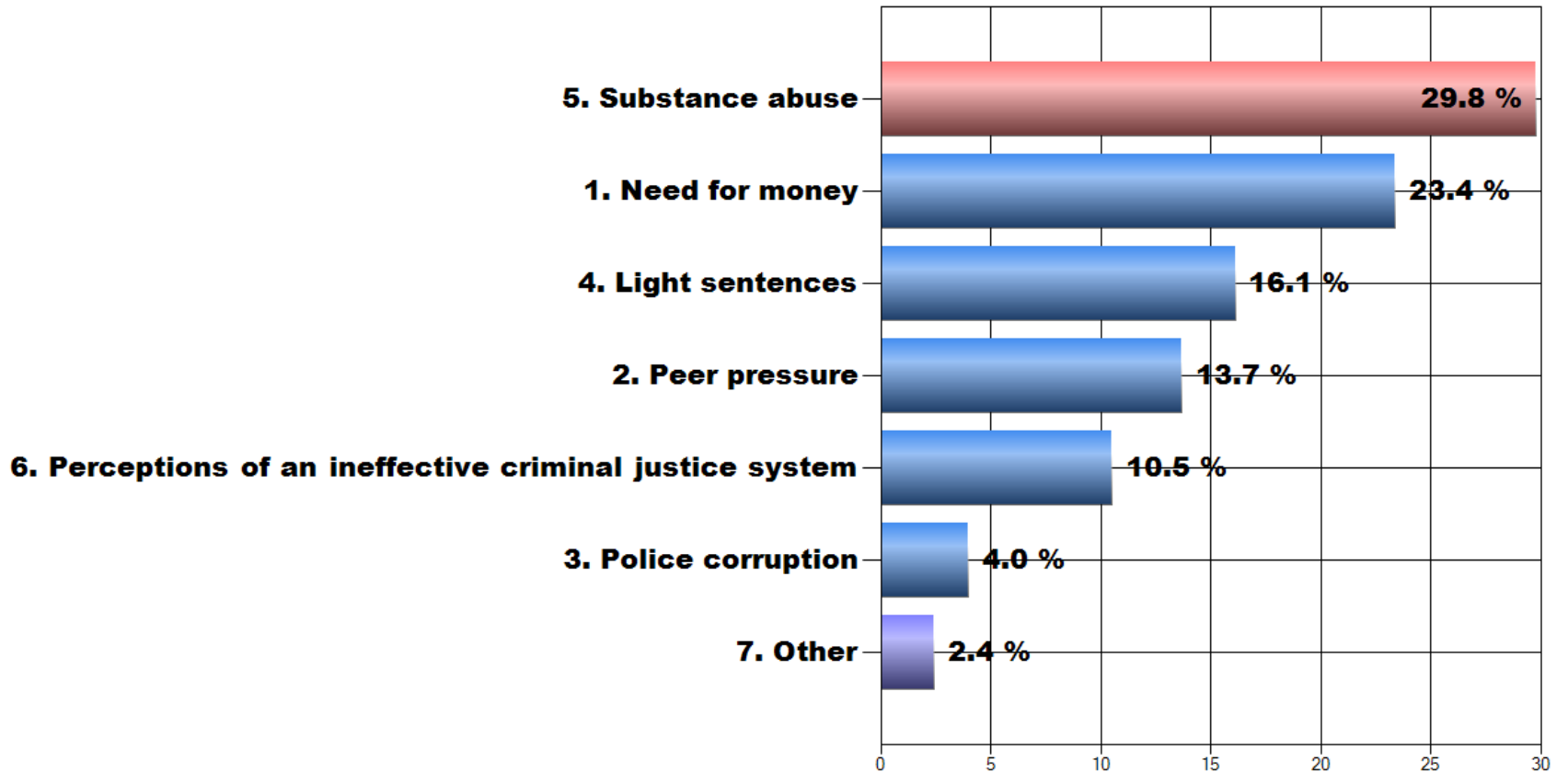

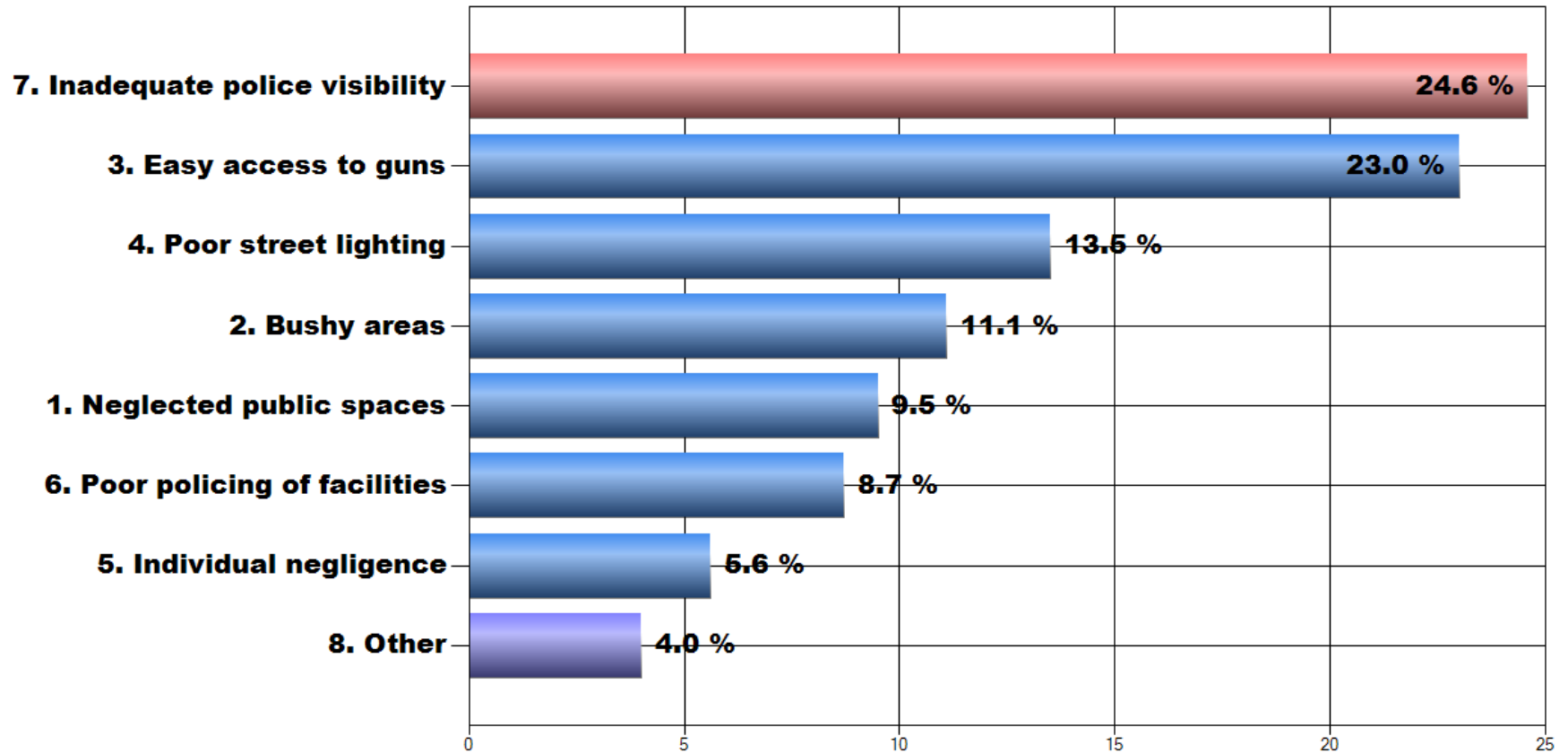

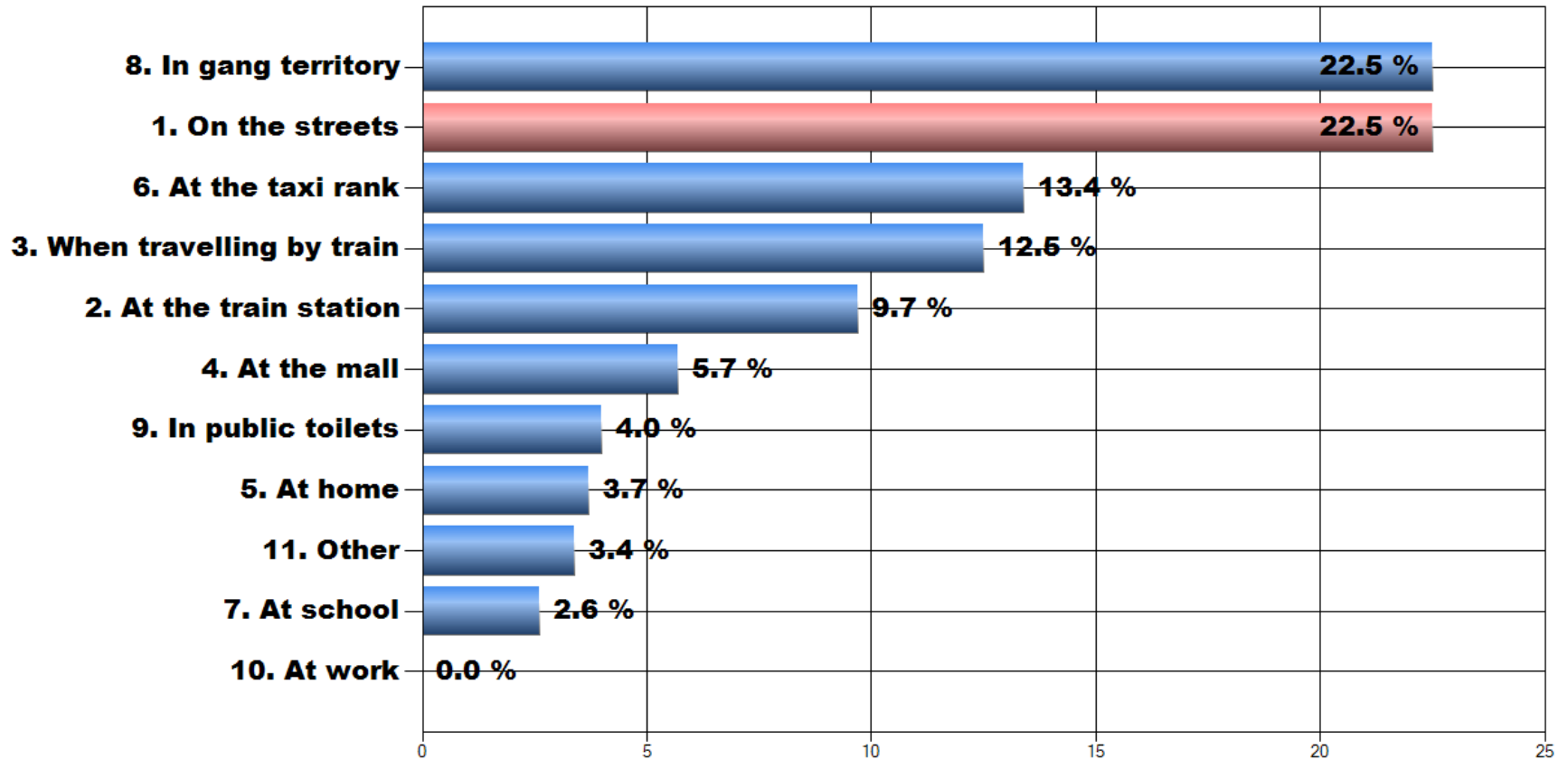

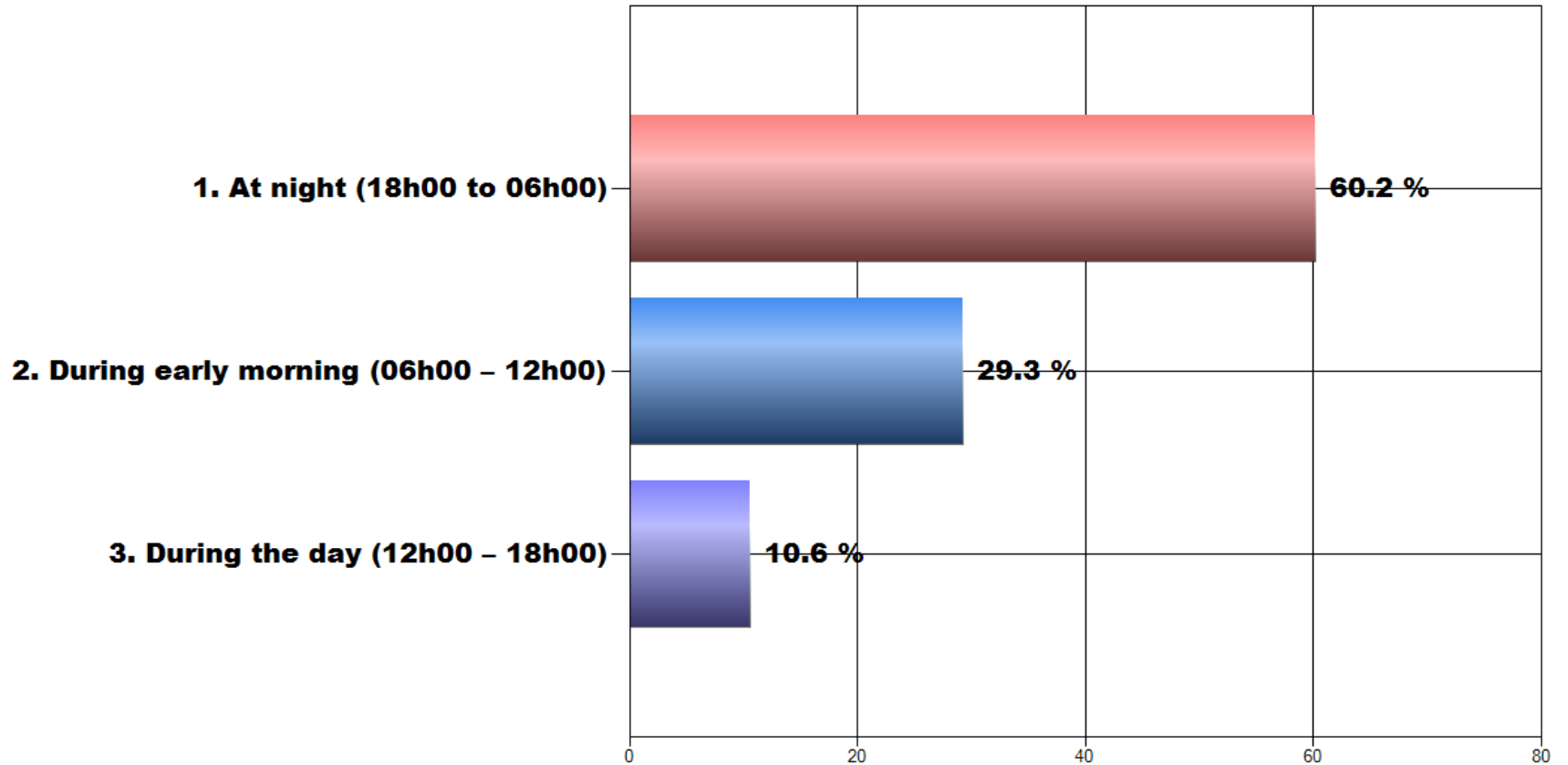

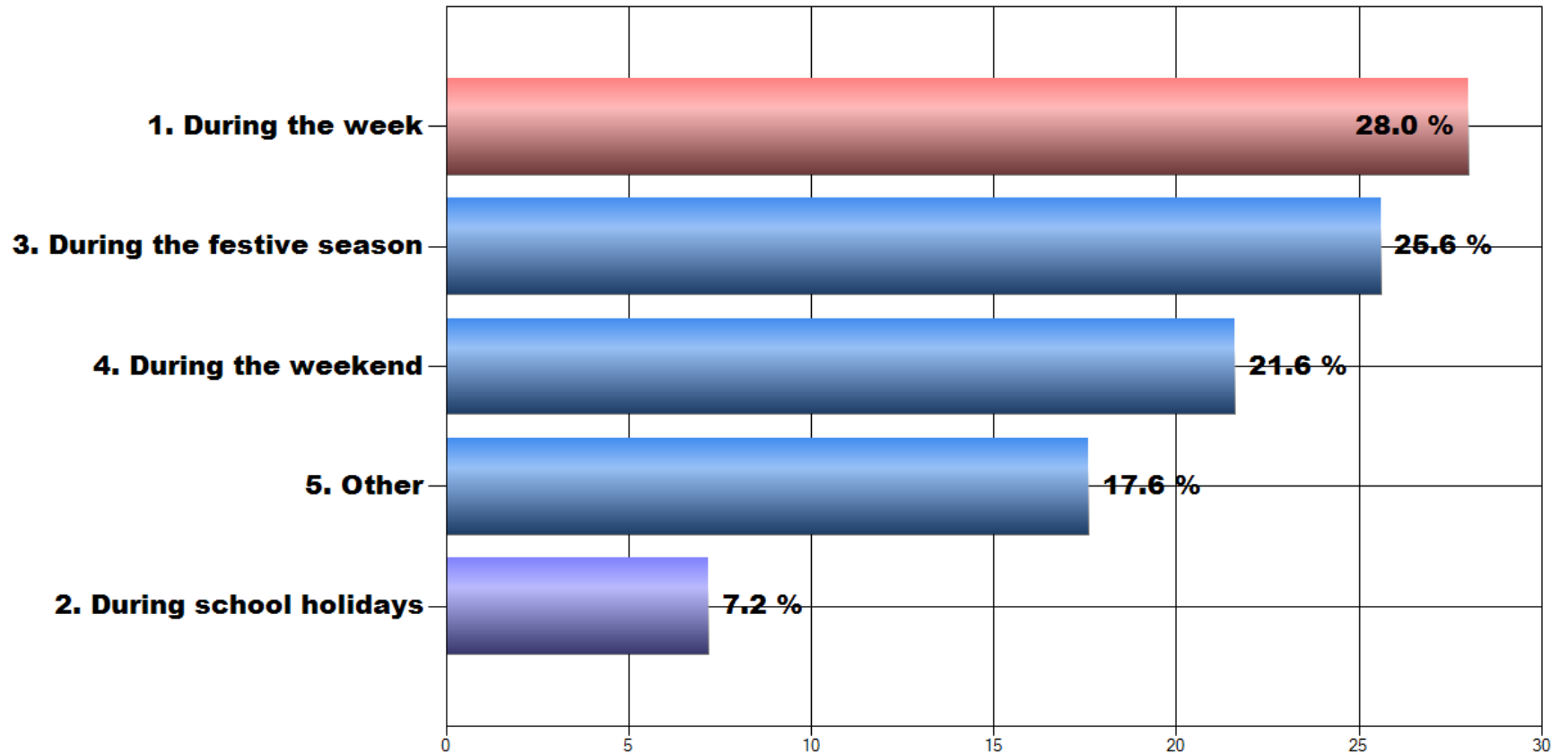

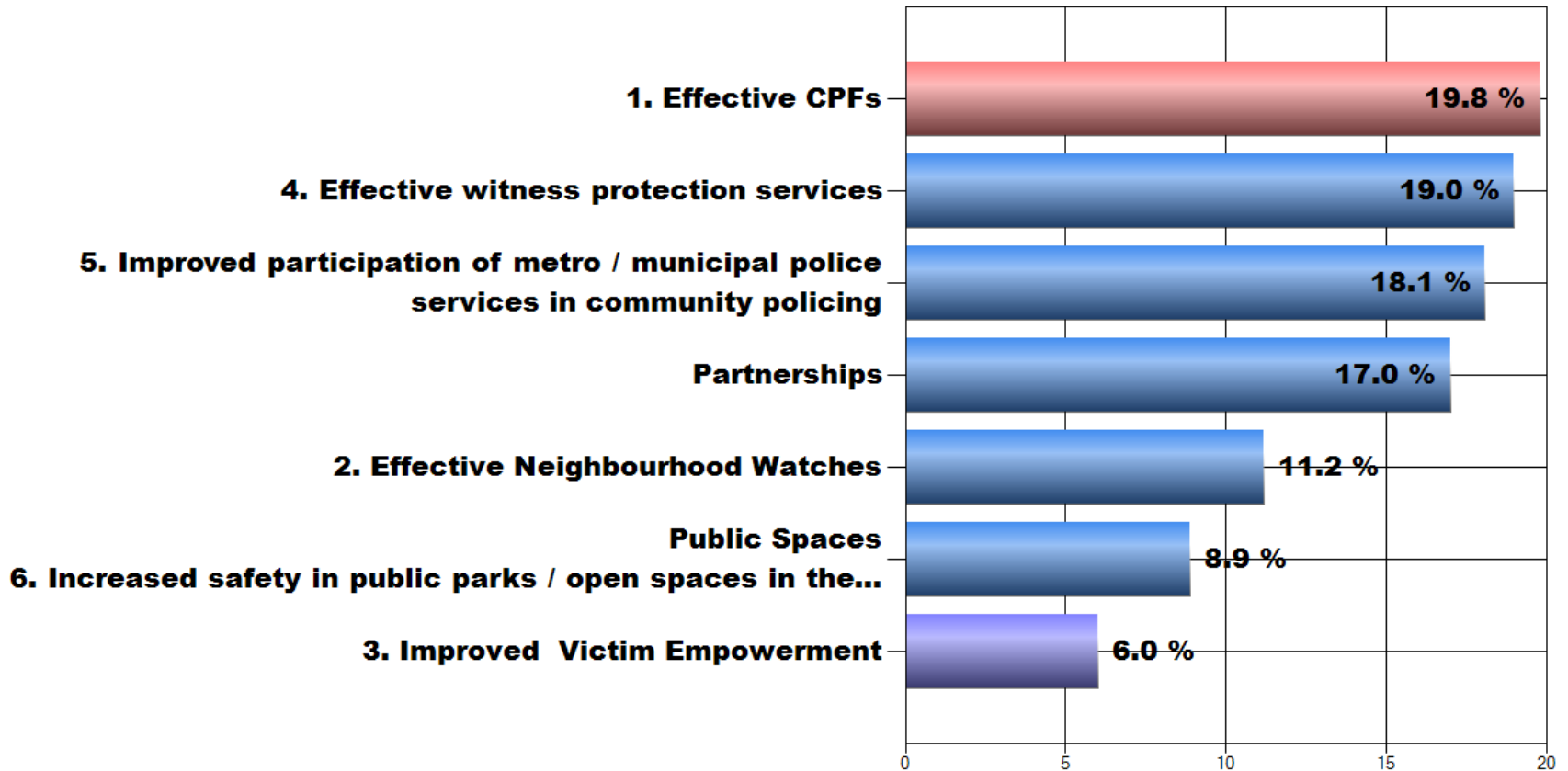

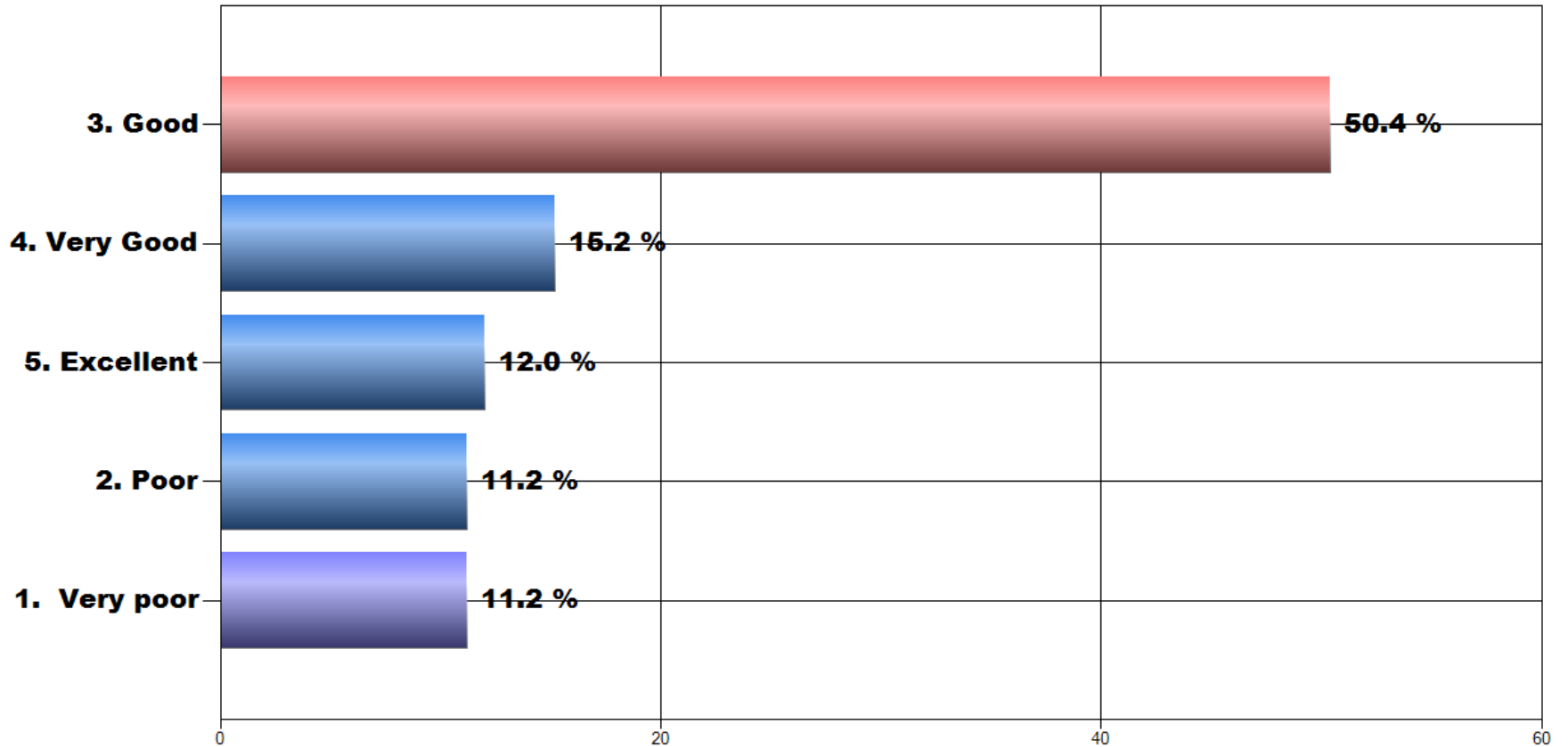
