(ACT NO. 20 OF 1998)****AMENDMENT OF DETERMINATION OF THE UPPER LIMITS OF THE
SALARIES, ALLOWANCES AND BENEFITS OF THE DIFFERENT MEMBERS
OF MUNICIPAL COUNCILS**

Under the powers vested in me by sections 7(1), 8(5)(a) and 9(5)(a) of the Remuneration of Public Office Bearers Act, 1998 (Act No. 20 of 1998), I, Fholisani Sydney Mufamadi, Minister for Provincial and Local Government, hereby-

- (a) after consultation with the member of the Executive Council responsible for local government in each province; and
- (b) after taking into consideration the matters listed in paragraphs (a) to (i) of section 7(1) of that Act; and
- (c) after taking into consideration the recommendations of the Commission in terms of sections 8(5)(a) and 9(5)(a) of that Act, respectively,

amend the determination under Government Notice No. R. 1319 of 18 October 2002 (as amended by Government Notice No. R. 1504 of 28 November 2002), of the upper limit of salaries, allowances and benefits of the different members of municipal councils as set out in the Schedule with effect from 1 February 2003.

(a) by the substitution for subparagraph (iv) of paragraph (b) of the following subparagraph:

“(iv) A councillor must elect one of the options set out in subparagraphs (i) and (ii) at the commencement of each financial year of municipalities: Provided that a councillor may not receive any allowance provided for in subparagraphs (i), (ii) and (iii) where the municipal council makes a vehicle available to that councillor.”; and

(b) by the substitution for paragraph (d) of the following paragraph:

“(d) *Housing allowance:*

A fixed housing allowance of not more than R31303.00 per annum: Provided that such an allowance is not payable where the municipal council makes housing available to the councillor concerned.”.

2. Item 8 of Government Notice No. R. 1319 of 18 October 2002 is hereby amended –

“(iv) A councillor must elect one of the options set out in subparagraphs (i) and (ii) at the commencement of each financial year of municipalities: Provided that a councillor, other than an executive mayor or a mayor where applicable, may not receive any allowance provided for in subparagraphs (i), (ii) and (iii) where the municipal council concerned makes a vehicle available to that councillor.”; and

(b) by the substitution for paragraph (c) of the following paragraph:

“(c) *Housing allowance:*

A fixed housing allowance of not more than R31303.00 per annum: Provided that such an allowance is not payable where the municipal council concerned makes housing available to the councillor concerned and such a councillor is not an executive mayor or a mayor.”.
