ACT

To amend the Western Cape Direct Charges Act, 2000; to provide for the withdrawal of roll-over funds from the Western Cape Provincial Revenue Fund, as a direct charge, before enactment thereof in an adjustments appropriation act; and to provide for matters incidental thereto

 ${f B}^{\rm E}$ IT ENACTED by the Provincial Parliament of the Western Cape, as follows:—

Amendment of section 1 of Act 6 of 2000

- **1.** Section 1 of the Western Cape Direct Charges Act, 2000 (hereafter "the principal Act"), is amended by the insertion after the definition of "Provincial Treasury" of the following definition:
 - "'Roll-over funds' means funds appropriated but not spent in a particular financial year, which have been approved by the Provincial Treasury for utilisation in the subsequent financial year.".

Insertion of section 7A in Act 6 of 2000

2. The following section is inserted after section 7 of the principal Act:

"Withdrawal of roll-over funds before adjustments budget is passed

7A. An accounting officer may, after approval of the roll-over funds by the Provincial Treasury, but before appropriation thereof in an adjustments appropriation Act, spend such roll-over funds for the approved purpose or 15 purposes, as a direct charge against the Provincial Revenue Fund.".

Short title and date of commencement

4. This Act is called the Western Cape Direct Charges Amendment Act, 2003, and comes into operation on a date determined by the Premier by proclamation in the *Provincial Gazette*.
