MULTI-AGENCY DELIVERY ACTION MECHANISM

"Heads of Departments should be personally involved to ensure effective and efficient service delivery"

Director-General in the inaugural meeting held on 27th of March 2003.

The MADAM Meeting of 3 July 2003 concluded that integration and co-ordination between governmental spheres should be institutionalised by focussing on a multi-agency implementation approach within and amongst different governmental spheres.

Heads of the involved Departments were adamant that the task team approach of MADAM should be implemented urgently to address the priority needs of the communities of the Western Cape.
