Library Week date change

In the September / October 2005 CL issue, featuring a preview of Library Week on page 14, the date for Library Week was given as 20-25 March 2006 which is in accordance with the decision taken by the Library and Information Association of South Africa (LIASA) 'that the week within which 20 March falls should be National Library Week. In the event of this day falling within a weekend, the week preceding it should be celebrated as National Library Week.'

However, the Executive Committee of LIASA has since released information that Library Week 2006 will be celebrated during 13-18 March with the theme, Libraries: partners in learning, nation building and development.

As the 20th falls on a Monday and the 21st is a public holiday, LIASA was of the opinion that the weekend would probably be regarded as a long weekend by many, therefore changed the date to ensure that a full week could be dedicated to Library Week.
