

## BURSARIES

The Western Cape Provincial Treasury invites matriculants, undergraduate and postgraduate students, interested in pursuing careers in the following fields, to apply for full-time bursaries:

- **Economics**
- **Fiscal and Public Policy**
- **Asset Management (Supply Chain Management, Physical Asset Management)**
- **Accounting**
- **Public Finance (Expenditure and Revenue Analysis and Management)**
- **Corporate Governance (Risk Management, Corporate Finance, Business and Public Administration)**

The Provincial Treasury is offering bursaries as part of our initiative to assist talented students, those willing to work hard and especially those who are financially stressed, so as to add to our contribution to address the existing skills shortage to meet future demands, and to provide an opportunity for qualifying students to pursue their studies. Interested candidates are therefore hereby invited to apply.

**Applicants must attach the following to their applications:** • A motivational letter of no longer than 600 words explaining why they wish to be enrolled • Proof of acceptance from the relevant academic institution • A certified copy of their academic results • A certified copy of a South African bar-coded identity document and certified household tax income statements/salary advices.

**Minimum requirements: Applicants must:** • Be a South African youth (17-35 years of age) • Preferably be resident/domiciled in the Western Cape • Have obtained an average of 60% or higher for the previous year of study at high school, university or technicon • Not be in possession of another bursary. Applicants' financial poverty index with regard to annual household income, in gradients of R50 000 and below, between R50 000 – R75 000, R75 000 – R100 000 and R100 000 plus, with preference given to poorer candidates. Postgraduate applicants should have already obtained a B. Degree within one or more of the fields indicated above

**Applicants must possess the following competencies:** • Results-orientation • High level of energy • Strong cognitive ability • Commitment and willingness to be interviewed by Provincial Treasury representatives.

**Differently abled persons are welcome to apply. Note: All successful applicants will be required to enter into contractual agreements with the Provincial Treasury.**
