On 2 December 2010 the Overstrand Municipality officially opened the Buffeljags Bay Wheelie Wagon for the small community of Buffeljags, 32km outside Gansbaai. The Buffeljags Wheelie Wagon project consists of two specially designed metal trolleys with lockable doors, containing about 1,000 books. These are housed in two rooms next to the community hall.
