Is misdaadfiksie die nuwe politieke novella? was een van die onderwerpe wat onlangs tydens die Franschhoek Literêre Fees onder bespreking was. Dr Francois Verster bespreek in sy reeks, *Skryfgedagtes*, hierdie interessante genre. In sy artikel, *Investigating crime in South Africa* op bladsy 18 brei ons boekkeurder, Stanley Jonck op sy beurt verder uit op die onderwerp en bespreek 'n hele aantal nuwe nie-fiksie titels met misdaad as onderwerp wat wissel van patologie tot ware misdaadverhale.

'Onse Mimi', 'n huishoudelike naam onder Suid-Afrikaners vir die alombekende Mimi Coertse - 'n wêreldbekende sopraan en op-erasanger, het onlangs haar 80ste verjaardag gevier. Ter viering van hierdie geleentheid bespreek Cherezaan Basadien, ons oudiovisuele keurder, 'n keur van boektitels en CD's in die Diens se versameling in haar artikel, *Our Mimi* op bladsy 38.
