[1] That the Respondent and its affiliated members are interdicted and

restrained from obstructing, interfering and stopping the transportation of

learners within the Western Cape;

[2] That the Respondent and its affiliated members are interdicted and

restrained from issuing threats to the Applicants, service providers, learners

and members of the public to the effect that they (the respondent) will

obstruct, interfere and stop the transporting of learners within the Western

Cape.

[3] The Respondent is ordered to pay costs.
